



The following properties of my houses were damages in the incident.

1. One Pucca house two store approx. 38 lakhs)
2. Paddy bags (150 no. of bags)
3. Cash (Rs 3 Lakhs)
4. Gold (20 San)
5. Domestic animals 40 ducks
6. Mahindra Zito value 2.3 lakhs.
7. One Scooty 60 thousand
8. Rice Mill 40 thousand.

The above damages properties worth above 55 Lakhs. I therefore, request to kindly taken up further legal action against the above unknown persons.
