I have the honour to report that, on 05/05/2023 at around 5:30 pm, the large number of kukis rioters with knives, sticks, iron rods, weapons sharp objects etc. broke into my house and destroyed my household items which was located at Mahika Village Kalapahar, PS - Kangpokpi, District - Kangpokpi.

The properties that were Destroy/Looted are as follows:

- i. Furniture - Rs 1,60,000/-
- ii. Utensils - Rs. 80,000/-
- iii. Garments - Rs. 90,000/-
- iv. Electrical Appliances - Rs 80,000/-
- v. Jewellery - Rs 40,000/-
- vi. Paddy Rice 40 Bags - Rs 60,000/-
- vii. Working Tools - Rs 40,000/-
- viii. Gas Cylinder/Stove - Rs 9500/-
- ix. Timbers - Rs 1,60,000/-
- x. Pigs, Dogs, Ducks & Hen - Rs 35,000/-

Total approximate value is about Rs. 7,54,500/- approximately.

Regarding the matters I couldn't able to report to the concern PS i.e. Kangpokpi PS till date due to the present situation in the State. Hence, I therefore reported to your good office for further procedure.

It is therefore, requested you to kindly look into the matter and take up necessary action at the earliest.
