I have the honour to report that, on 04/05/2023 at around 8:30 am, the large number of kukis rioters with knives, sticks, iron rods, weapons sharp objects etc. broke into my house and completely destroyed the house and looted much of my properties located at Dalli village, PS – Kangpokpi, District - Kangpokpi.

The properties that were dismantled/looted are as follows:

- i. Semi pucca House – Rs. 6,00,000/-
- ii. Phou Kei – Rs. 50,000/-
- iii. Furniture – Rs. 50,000/-
- iv. Utensil – Rs. 30,000/-
- v. Garments – Rs. 40,000/-
- vi. Electronic – Rs. 40,000/-
- vii. Power Tiller Kamco – Rs. 1,60,000/-
- viii. Paddy (Rice) 60 bags – 1,05,000/-
- ix. Gas cylinder 3 nos. – Rs. 10,000/-
- x. Gas stove – Rs. 2,500/-
- xi. Cattle 4 nos. – Rs. 1,00,000/-
- xii. Ducks, hen – Rs. 20,000/-
- xiii. Documents ( class X, XII, gas book)

Total approximate value is about Rs. 12,07,500/- approximately.

Regarding the matters I couldn't able to report to the concern PS i.e. Kangpokpi PS till date due to the present situation in the State. Hence, I therefore reported to your good office for further procedure.
