Today i.e. On 02/02/2023 at around 10:30 am a joint team of Kangpokpi, District, Police, NCB, Forest Department, SDM (Executive Magistrate) Kangpokpi, numbering about 79 (Seventy nine) persons led by Shri Sheimang Khongsai, MPS DSP (GSPM) KPI, Kangpokpi under the supervision of Shri Dr. Vikramjit Singh, MPS SPIKPI was deputed to carried out a mass destruction of illicit poppy plants cultivation in the hills ranges of Moluom Village and Tumnaupokpi Village under Saikul Sub-Division, Kangpokpi, District, Manipur about 18 Kms west from the Saikul Police Station. As per destruction Order issued by SDM (Executive Magistrate) Dtd 2/02/2023 the combine teams destroyed about 26 (twenty five) acres which were cultivated in hill ranges between Moluom Village and Tumnaupokpi Village under Saikul Police Station, Kangpokpi District, Manipur. The expected yields per acres is 10 Kgs. The approximate value of the destroyed poppy plantation is calculated at Rs. 17,5,00,000 (Seventeen Crore and five lakhs).

Hence, a Sub-Matter case under FIR NO. 8(02) 2023 SKL-PS Uls 18(6) NDBPS Act has been registered for investigation.
