

Sir,

With due respect, I am to report that on 27/05/2023, a large group of Meitei miscreants attacked my store (Garments) at checkon imphal. The criminals forcibly opened the shutter and destroyed, vandalized, looted my stuffs and all my belongings as noted below.

I, along with my family (husband and son) stay in a rented house of Pa Seilen Haokip at Pureiromba leikai, Chassad Avenue, Imphal. Fortunately, me and my family had a narrow escaped from the horrible situation who even tried to kill us.

List of properties which were damaged, looted and burnt down are as follows:

1) Deep Refrigerator Worth	Rs 40,000/-
2) Clothes and Pants Worth	Rs 2,00,000/-
3) Gift items worth	Rs 80,000/-
4) Bedspread with pillow cover worth	Rs 50,000/-
5) Foot Wears worth	Rs 60,000/-
6) Almira's with Glass frame worth	Rs 80,000/-
7) Blankets 12pcs worth	Rs 20,000/-
8) Tables, chairs and Jumbo boxes worth	Rs 30,000/-
9) Miscellaneous	Rs 2000/-
<b>Grand Total worth</b>	<b>Rs 5,62,000</b>

It is, therefore, requested to kindly take up necessary legal action against the unknown culprits. Cause of delay in reporting on time is due to displacement and volatile law and order situation.
