



I have the honour to report that on 29/05/2023 at around 3:30 pm, some kukis militant numbering about 20/30 with sophisticated armed, knives, iron rod, and weapon sharp object have come and vandalized/destroyed as well as looted many valuable items in the rented house owned by Langam Singte located at Leimakhong bazar.

The properties that were vandalized/looted are as follows:

1. House hold properties including 6 rice bags – Rs. 17000/-
2. Gold (6 Mohor's) – Rs. 408000/-
3. Cash – Rs. 3 lacs
4. 4 nos bed – Rs. 72000/-
5. Almirah 3 nos – Rs. 400000/-
6. Dining table and chairs – Rs. 48000/-
7. Sopha set – Rs. 60000/-
8. Clothing – Rs. 2 lacs

Total approximate value is about Rs. 1,505,000/- approximately.

Regarding the matters I couldn't able to report to the concern PS i.e. Gamnon Sapormeina PS till date due to the present situation in the State. Hence, I therefore reported to your good office for further procedure.

It is therefore, requested you to kindly look into the matter and take up necessary action at the earliest.
