Subject: FILING OF FIR AGAINST ARMED RIOTERS

Sir,

- Internal Security Duty columns of Assam Rifles were deployed in the general area of K. Songlung village for protection of civilians and maintaining peace as per the requisition made by the Govt. of Manipur.
- On 02 Jun at approx. 1715 hours- 1830 hours of Bethel. Nakujang village under Kangchup PS KPI Dist and K. Songlung were burnt by mob. Firing stopped at 1930 hours and restarted at 2345 hours between K Songlung village and K Chingkhong village. Several houses of K Chingkhong village were burnt at 0030 hours. During the firefight seven civilians were injured.
- A column of Assam Rifles co-ordinated with SP Imphal West and launched multiple small teams to control the situation and managed to push back volunteers from Tuikun village thereby creating a buffer-zone between the fire fight. Assam Rifles troops responded in a calibrated manner with controlled fire, in selfdefense and for protection of civilians in the area. No casualties were reported by locals/forces during the said incidents.
- You are requested to kindly file and FIR against unknown armed miscreants and investigate the incident for attempt to murder with deadly weapons, to deter public servants suppressing riots, causing hurt 4. with dangerous weapons and unlawful carriage of dangerous weapons and unauthorised usage of firearms and ammunition to include automatic weapons.
