

Subject : First Information Report (FIR).

Respected Sir,

I, Smti. T Caroline Haokip (54) W/o Late M. Thangkhosei Haokip Resident of National Game Village, Zone III, B163, Imphal West District , Manipur -795004 under Lamphel ,Police Station, permanent residents of the above address since 20 years. That on 3 May 2023 around 7:30 PM, The Meitei mobs namely, the Arambai Tenngol and the neighbouring Meitei villagers start attacking our area and surrounding, Lamphel area, we escaped leaving behind all our belongings and properties to nearby safer neighbouring house and took refuge till the next day i.e. the 4th of may, On the 4th of may At around 7:30 am in the morning the Central Force CRPF escorted us to the nearest CRPF Camp near D.C. Office. We stayed in the Camp for three days. It was on the 7 May 2023 that we were escorted to Motbung, Kangpokpi District by the CRPF. On the 17th of May 2023 after staying there for 10 days, My two Sons and I move to Gauhati by road as it was still not safe there.

Then after reaching Gauhati on the 18 of May around 2pm we took off for Aizawl by Flight and reached around 3pm and stay there till 27 June 2023. On 28 June we came to Shillong by road and stay here till date as my two son were enable to continue their studies. We registered ourselves with the relief committee in Shillong and stayed with our relatives there for a week. Then we rented a house at Nongrim Hills East Khasi Hills District Meghalaya.

Since all our properties and belongings were left behind we did not have anything with us as we escape from death. As per the information we got from our neighbour through phone calls that the whole properties were looted, destroyed and later they (the Meitei) family occupied and stayed where those that remains were stolen and looted.

The following are the list of belongings, property loss and damaged.

10. Utensils Rs.70,000
11. Mattress Rs.50,000
12. Suitcase Rs.3800
13. Blanket Rs.20,000
14. Gold ornaments Rs.1,00,000
15. Fridge Rs 15000
16. Traditional Shawls Rs. 1,20,000
17. Assessories Rs 80,000

Total = 9,34,6000 (Nine Lakhs Thirty Four Thousands)only.

Therefore, I urge you to initiate a swift action to bring all involve criminals to Justice through proper investigation in to the matter and book the culprits under appropriate sections of the Law of the land and kindly compensate us with all our losses. Most importantly, bring peace and permanent solution to this conflict as in way of Separate Administration to the Kuki-Zo groups. We are hoping that justice is served in the earliest.
