Respected Sir,

We are residents of the above address since 30 years. On hearing about the incidents around our city we had moved out to CRPF Camp on 4th May. After we move to the camp we got to know that our house had been vandalised and destroyed. Our house had items worth Rs. 42,00,000/-. From there we escaped to Shillong due to fear of losing our lives. Due to this we went through a lot of mental trauma was soo traumatised that even my saliva dried and was filled with fear.

I and my family were targeted because we were from the Kuki Tribe and we no longer have a home to stay. I work in RIMS as a section Officer and since our house was destroyed and the church also has been vandalised. I have no idea how long I will be paid as I had to leave the state/ My daughter was working on contract and no longer has a salary. My son and daughter were studying in Universities in Manipur and no longer able to continue the same.

I would be retiring in 3 years time, but now all my life's savings have been vandalised and looted and I don't know if I will even get the pension for which I worked all my life.

Due to the displacement, I and my children have gone through terrible losses financially and are suffering from mental trauma and are left with no hope right now.

Hence, we request you to restore the situation to normalcy and help us get financial help to build our homes back and help us settle back to our city where I and my children have grown up and been for most part of our life.

We are hoping for justice for us and all our people from this situation.
