





Respected Sir,

We are the residents of the above address since 2003 and have been staying in my own residence. On the 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2023, when our neighbor house was burnt, and the Meitei people moved around, we ran out for our life leaving everything of our properties with our shirts, blouse and pants worn by us only. We were empty handed when we left our house. We were given shelter for a moment by our Meitei neighbor. After that we ran into the women police compound and then to the Lamphel Police Station. From there the CRPF escorted us to their camp at Lamphelpat. On 6<sup>th</sup> May 2023 we moved to Guwahati by flight and entered Shillong. On 28<sup>th</sup> May 2023 our house was ransacked, and completely destroyed, looted our properties and burnt our properties outside. I was attacked



by the Meitei people, because we are Tribals and Christians. I am a retired Government servant and I have 5 family members and one is studying. My properties that were damaged amount to Rs 27,20,000 and one Scooty Honda Activa worth Rs 50,000 has been burnt.

Hence, we request you to restore the situation to normalcy and grant us compensation and rehabilitation.

We are hoping for Justice for us and for all who are in this situation and to book the culprits as per sections of the Law.

As it is not possible for us to go back to Imphal, we demand a separate administration for the hill tribals under the Indian Constitution.
