We are the residents of the above address since the last few years. On 03 May, 2023, our locality was attacked by a mob and few houses were burnt down. In view of the dangerous condition, our family had to take shelter at CRPF camp in Lamphel the very next day on 04 May 2023. Our family stayed in the CRPF camp for 5 days before we were evacuated by the Indian Army to Kangpokpi on 08 May 2023. From there we came to Shillong in view of the volatile condition prevailing in Manipur.

ASI, L. Premanounda Sing Due to these incidents, our family is facing a lot of hardships as we have been rendered homeless and it has given everyone of us mental trauma. We have no idea if our property is still standing or burnt down or looted and vandalised.

Hence, I request you to kindly investigate the matter and take action against the perpetrators. And also to take necessary steps to protect our property and the whole locality from arsonists and

We are hoping for justice for us and for all who are in this situation.
