We are the residents of the above address since last 21 years and have been staying on a rented house. On the 3th May, 2023, Meitei Mobs began attacking our locality, coming in hundreds, and we were left defenseless. We had no choice but to flee and seek refuge at a CRPF camp. We stayed there for five days, after which arrived at Shillong, with our children's education in consideration.

Who were the ones who attacked you?

- Meitei Mob, because we belong to a certain community (Hmar). I work with the Indian Reserve Battalion and I have 3 children who are studying. Approximately 60 lakhs is the possession I had. None of the vehicles were damaged.
