Subject : Zero FIR

Sir,

I would like to inform you that due to inconveniences on my part, I could not lodge an FIR in the jurisdiction of the occurrence i.e. Manipur. So, I am submitting my complaint u/s 154 Cr.P.C. for registration of Zero FIR.

That, on the 3rd of May, 2023, "**Tribal Solidarity March**" was organised under the leadership of All Tribal Students Union, Manipur (ATSUM) in all the hill districts of Manipur against the demand for inclusion of the dominant Meetei community into the ST lists of the Constitution of India.

That, after the said rally was organised peacefully, some miscreants suspected be Meetei/Meitei burnt the **Anglo-Kuki War Centenary Gate** located in Churachandpur District, Manipur and fled away soon thereby infuriating the locals. This led to bloody fight between the tribals and the Meiteis. The house of some of the participants in the said rally were also torched by the Meitei mobs. This led to outburst of anger and burning of houses by one community against another community ensued.

That, the violence which was confined to the Churachandpur and Bishnupur district of Manipur area soon spread like wildfire and in no time, all parts of the Imphal valley were also affected.

That, the Meitei mobs spearheaded by Arambai Tenggol and Meitei Leepun attacked National Games Village, Imphal, Manipur at around 8:41 p.m. and then it attacked my locality i.e. Langol Housing Complex, Imphal West, Manipur and its adjoining areas i.e. Phaipijaang, Langol at around 11 p.m.

That, the mobs also burnt down Langol Christian Church (LCC) and Gilgal Presbyterian Church (GPC) on the night of 3rd May, 2023. The Chowkidar and some people who took refuge in the Church premises escaped as soon as the violent and huge mob started banging the gate and forcing their way through in.

That, the Meitei mob led by Arambai Tenggol and Meitei Leepun also burnt down around Five houses as of 03/05/2023 in and around my locality. The mob also lynched one person belonging to the tribal Kuki community James Lunminlal Khongsai on the night of 3rd May, 2023 at his residence and the said person is confirmed dead. It is divine intervention and the presence of Army and CRPF personnels that further damage to our lives and property were prevented. The violent mobs escaped and withdrew only after the marching of Army and CRPF personnels with shoot at sight orders in our locality.

That, my family members alongwith me fled to the nearest camp i.e 86 BN CRPF, Lamphel, Manipur for our safety. That due to the sudden happenings, my family members and I could not secure many important documents like Jamabandi, Certificates, Manipur Govt. issued one Laptop etc. After staying in the said CRPF camp for two days, on 6th May, 2023 we could barely manage to get out of Manipur.

That, taking advantage of our absence, Meitei mobs also vandalised and looted my household properties.

In the light of these reasons, I as an Indian Citizen prayed before you to kindly initiate necessary action as per the law of the land against Arambai Tenggol and his supporters, Meitei Leepun and the mobs so that there is justice.
