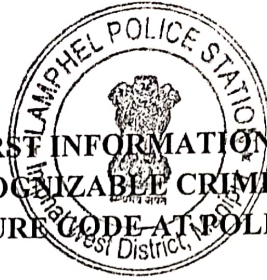

Subject:- Report.



Sir,

I have the honour to state that today i.e. 30/10/2023 at about 01:30 pm, received a reliable information from our own source about the presence of some suspected illegal drugs inside the godown of Network Courier Service located near Lamphel Fishery Crossing. The information was reduced in writing and informed to our senior officers. Based on the information, a team of CDO-IW consisting of Inspector P. Achouba Meetei, OC-CDO-IW and myself led by Shri Md. Riyajuddin, MPS, (Addl.SP), Dy.SP(Ops.)IW (Gazetted Police Officer) under the command of Shri M. Amit Singh, MPS, Addl.SP(Ops.)IW and under the overall supervision of Shri. Ksh. Shivakanta Singh, IPS, SP-IW rushed to the said area. Later on, Executive Magistrate namely Samukcham Jemmy, SDC Central-II, Imphal West arrived at the said area after requisition. Accordingly, the police team along with the above mentioned Executive Magistrate entered the godown of Network Courier Service and conducted search inside the said godown. During the search, some boxes labeled with "PRODUCT NAME:- CODEDYL-CT COUGH SYRUP" were found. On opening one of the boxes in presence of the witnesses including the above mentioned Executive Magistrate and Gazetted Police Officer, 160 nos. of CODEDYL-CT cough syrup 100 ml bottles containing Codeine Phosphate IP 10 mg per bottle (also a controlled item) were found. On enquiry, manager of Network Courier Service namely Amom Malemsemba Meitei (36 yrs.) S/o. (L) Amom Jugol Meitei of Sagolband Khamnam Leirak and confirmed that this COUGH SYRUP consignment was coming into the name of CITY PHARMACY MANIPUR IMPHAL 795001 and he produced an Invoice Bill bearing docket number 3001222832 in this regard. He further stated that he did not know the contents of the boxes. On further opening of the remaining 39 nos. of boxes, similar cough syrup bottles were also found, each box containing 160 nos. of CODEDYL-CT cough syrup 100 ml bottles containing Codeine Phosphate IP 10 mg per bottle. Therefore, a total 40 nos. of boxes containing 6400 bottles of CODEDYL-CT cough syrup 100 ml containing Codeine Phosphate IP 10 mg per bottle (each box contains 160 bottles i.e. 40 boxes X 160 bottles = 6400 bottles) were recovered from the spot.

From our own source it came to know that the owner of the above recovered boxes containing cough syrup bottles is Md. Siraj @ Athoi S/o. Md. Noor Jamal of Khurai Khumidok. Further, hectic efforts are made to arrest Md. Siraj @ Athoi at the earliest.

Hence, the above recovered articles along with the above mentioned Invoice Bill bearing docket number 3001222832 were seized from the spot at 05:00 pm by observing formalities.

Therefore, the seized articles are handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.
