## LODGING OF FIR AGAINST MEIRA PAIBIS AND UNLF (P)

- 1. At around 0830h on 13 Apr 24, input was received of fire fight at General Area Monghlam village. Security Forces Columns deployed in General Area Maphou (GR 616901) and Island (GR 603857) were immediately mobilised to forward locations to diffuse the situation. The team of Police, IRB and Manipur Commandos also reached the location between 1000h to 1030h.
- 2: The Column deployed at Village Nongdam Thangkul also intercepted the movement of UNLF(P) (a proscribed terrorist outfit under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act, 1967) from Nongdam Thangkul towards Monghlam which were moving in 07 vehicles between 1200h to 1330h on 13 Apr 2024. The UNLF (P) were heavily armed and when the Column Commander of Security Forces attempted to confiscate their weapons, the vehicles were intentionally diverted towards Tumukhong Village. The Column tried to relentlessly pursue the fleeing group but was deliberately prevented from entering Tumukhong Village by a violent mob of Meira Paibis who intentionally obstructed the movement of Security Forces.
- 3. Simultaneously, a Column from General Area Hanuman Top (GR 557913) was also mobilized, however, it was also deliberately prevented from reaching Tumukhong Village due to intentional dugging of road one kilometre short of Oksu Village towards Moirengpurel. The movement of Security Forces was also intentionally blocked by the mob of Meira Paibis at Moirangpurel Village thereby preventing the Security Forces from lawful discharge of their duty. (The Photographs of the ibid unlawful blockade by the mob are attached).
- 4. The actions of Meira Paibis and UNLF(P) on 13 Apr 2024 were unlawful, violent, and amounted to several cognizable offences under the Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860 and the Arms Act, 1959. They obstructed the public servants in discharge of their official duty, assembled unlawfully and riotously, intimidated and threatened the security forces and the villagers, possessed illegal arms and ammunition. The said rioters may immediately be identified and arrested as per the due process of law.
- 5. In view of the above, FIR against unknown/ unidentified Meira Paibis in General Area Tumukhong & Moirangpurel in General Area Tumukhong and Nongdam Thangkul villages may be lodged for the following offences:-
  - (a) Obstructing Public Servants from discharge of their official duty in suppressing and dispersing unlawful assembly contrary to the aforementioned provision incl Sec 353, 503, 504, 505 and 506 of the IPC.
  - (b) Obstructing the Public Servants in apprehending the armed miscreants and unlawfully resisting their arrest contrary to Sec 201, 223, 224, and 225 of the IPC.
  - (c) Assisting/ aiding escape of the armed miscreants while performing bonafide military duty in Aid to Civil Authorities, contrary to Sec 201, 223, 224 and 225 of the IPC.

- Criminal Intimidation, Assault and Criminal Force against Public Servants discharging public duty in Aid to Civil Authorities contrary to Sec 34, 120, 350, 353 and 332 of the IPC.
- (e) Committing mischief with intent to cause destruction of any property or any such change in property as destroys or diminishes it's value contrary to Sec 425 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
- (f) Committing mischief by causing damage to public property contrary to Sec 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984
- Further it is requested that FIR against unknown/ unidentified UNLF(P) moving with the weapons in contravention of the Model Code of Conduct, in General Area Tumukhong and Nongdam Thangkul villages may be lodged for the following offences:-
  - Possession of illegal arms and ammunitions contrary to S 25(1C) and S 27 of Arms Act, 1959.
  - (b) Criminal Intimidation, Assault and Criminal Force against Public Servants discharging public duty in Aid to Civil Authorities contrary to Sec 34, 120, 350, 353 and 332 of the IPC.
  - Rioting while being armed with a deadly weapon or with anything which if used as a weapon is likely to cause death contrary to Sec 146, 147,148 and 149 of the IPC.
  - (d) Obstructing Public Servants from discharge of their official duty in suppressing and dispersing unlawful assembly contrary to the aforementioned provn incl Sec 353, 503, 504, 505 and 506 of the IPC.
- The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari Vs Govt of UP (MANU/ SC/1166/ 2013) has held "It is mandatory to file the FIR u/s 154 of the Code if the information discloses the commission of a cognizable crime and no preliminary investigation is permissible in such a case". In deference to the Hon'ble SC ruling, you are requested to register a First Information Report against the above mentioned persons.
- It is requested that action taken post registering of FIR and identification as well as initiation of legal action in respect of perpetrators of above crimes be intimated in laid down time frame(without waiting for invoking of the provisions of the Right to Information Act. 2005). A copy of the FIR, and the police report on completion of the investigation in terms of Section 173 (2)(ii) of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 may please be provided to this office for our records please.
