I have the honour to report you that on 03/05/2023, I along with other villagers escaped from Kwatha Khunou village where only 13 (thirteen) houses are inhabited. We took shelter in Kwatha Khunjao where located at a distance of 6(six) Kilometres only. We could not took care of our left out houses. But few of us including the village chief on a Shaktiman under the escort of Assam Rifle had visited at our Village Kwatha Khunou in August' 2023. On reaching our village, it was learnt that all the household items i.e -

1. Washing machine	- Rs. 18,000
2. Refrigerator	- Rs. 14,000
3. 3(three) wooden beds (Teak)	- Rs. 60,000
4. 1(one) wooden Almirah	- Rs. 30,000
5. 1(one) Activa Red in colour	- Rs. 80,000
6. 1(one) T.V set (Sony)	- Rs. 15,000
7. 5(five) Cows	- Rs. 200000
8. 60(sixty) Hen	- Rs. 50,000
9. 2(two) Pigs	- Rs. 50,000
10. 3(three) Ceiling Fans	- Rs. 7,000
11. 10(ten) bags of Rice	- Rs. 10,000

were stolen away by the Kuki armed militants from my house.


I could not lodged any FIR to the Police as we had been in Kwatha Khunjao by taking shelter and only on 21/02/2024 we came at Imphal, escorted by the Assam Rifle. We are now staying in Langol Game Village Zone-I, Temporary shelter.

You are therefore requested to register a case against the unknown Kuki armed militants as per law. *The cause of delaying my report is due to displacement from one place to another and lack of knowledge.*
