Subject: Report on the loss of property during the ongoing violence of Manipur.

Sir,

With due respect, I would like to report on the losses that occurred during the ongoing crisis that erupted sporadically in Manipur since May 3rd.

I the undersigned is a residence of Kwatha and the farm where I met my losses is at Kwatha Khunou (7 km from my residence). Since Kwatha happens to be at the vicinity of Indo-Myanmar, threats exist on the advent of Military Coup in Myanmar, settlement and farm activities were difficult for the locals as PDF militant hovered around the border. Finally, In March 2022 when Military Junta air strike on their rebels like People Defense Force (PDF), PDF militants and their counterparts were driven out from the vicinity of Kwatha Khunou border area; border tension was lowered, normalcy was brought and local activities like farming were resumed at Kwatha Khunou effectively.

But unfortunately, when the violence broke out in Manipur, PDF militant infiltrated the border and took shelter near my farmhouse. That is when they started vandalizing my farm and looted my farm products, equipments, furniture and other valuable items mentioned below.

So, I write to report my loss of property (@Kwatha Khunou) during the ongoing violence.

1. That, on 7/5/2023 at around 4:50 p.m. Some **PDF militant outfit** from across the Indo-Myanmar border along with the **Kuki Militants** stormed our locality with arms and other incriminating weapon. They have looted and vandalized my farm house (Cattle/Poultry/Household items/ Furniture's/Electrical Equipment's/Food items along with valuable items.)

2. That the value of lost/damaged properties is around **₹29,56,500/-** the details of the items are given below:

a. Fish from two ponds @Kwatha Khunou having an area of 90x86m and 75x55m valued about **₹6,00,000/-**.

b. Farm house located @Kwatha Khunou estimated approximately **₹4,00,000/-**

c. **Damaged items:** -Orange tree about 2612nos. $₹120 \times 2612 = ₹3,13,440$

Lemon tree 3001nos. $₹60 \times 3001 = ₹1,80,060/-$

Avocado tree 116nos. $₹250 \times 116 = ₹29,000 /-$

Bean tree (Yongchak) 1013nos. $₹50 \times 1013 = ₹50,650/-$

Betel nut tree 3000nos. $₹80 \times 3000 = ₹2,40,000/-$
