Subject : Report on vandalism, looting, burning of documents, damaged on valuable properties on moveable/immovable.

Sir,

I am here to bring to your notice that I am residence quarter of National Game Village, Zone-III, A/101, Imphal West, Manipur.

On 4<sup>th</sup> May 2023, we left our residential quarter as compel due to the sudden outbreak of the ethnic violence on 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2023 to CRPF camp, Lamphel, Imphal West for security reason. On 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 we left Imphal for Delhi by flight.

During our stayed at Delhi, It has come to our knowledge that our residential quarter was vandalized and burnt, looted all our valuable properties including documents by unknown miscreants.

The approximate lost of properties is worth about Rs. 1,463,000/-.

The reason behind on delay in complaining is due to fleeing at Delhi on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2023 and stay almost seven months there. I went for filing zero FIR at Delhi Police Station but they rejected me and told me to file at home town. So, as I do today.

Therefore, with utmost respect, I request you to kindly take strong action against the perpetrators by registering on FIR under relevant sections of Indian Panel Code.
