**Sub:- Registration of F.I.R against destruction and looting of a residential building
at Langol, Imphal West.**

Sir,

I beg to state the following few fact relating to the subject above for favour of kind
necessary action please.

That, since ethnic violence in Manipur, my husband who belongs to a Tamil
community have been occupying and taking care of my residential building located at
Hill Side colony, Langol Imphal. However and unfortunately while my husband was
away on official duty outside, on 11th February 2024, miscreants ransacked my building.
Not only did they break open the door, they dislocated all the five doors of the building
and whisked them away including all the assets inside the building.

The list of items stolen on the day alongwith approximate value is shown as follows:-
