

That, on the 15th of July, 2023 at around 8:30 PM, and with the help of a good friend belonging to another Tribe/Community, it came to my knowledge that a group of Meetei / Meitei miscreants broke open the door of my house and in the process they have vandalized the in-build assets (windows, doors & other installations) along with my household items/ movable properties.

That, it may also be report that the said criminal activities have cause grave mental agony and incurred huge lose which is estimated to be about *Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty Lakhs)* Only, exclusive of my house.

That, I humbly pray you to kindly register a ZERO FIR, and booked the perpetrators under the relevant laws of our Country. And for which act of kindness I shall always remain grateful to you. Thus, I am filing this application today.
