Subject: Information

Sir,

1. Indian Army columns are deployed in General Area Maphou. On 25 May 2024, a vehicle based column was moving towards General Area Monghlam on an area domination patrol. At around 1330 hours, the column detected a suspicious black object hanging on a tree in the road connecting Nongdam Tangkhul and Itham Tangkhul. On a detailed checking and assessment by representatives of bomb disposal team, 03 x remote control IEDs with command mechanism, 25 metres cordtex, 01 x live round of AK 47, 01 x live round of INSAS, 03 x fired case and 03 x lithium cells were recovered.
2. The recovered IEDs alongwith other war like stores were handed over to the Thoubal Dam police as per seizure memo. (Copy of seizure memo enclosed).
3. It is requested to send these IEDs to FSL Analysis Laboratory, Pangei to investigate the details of explosives used in the IEDs.
4. It is also requested to investigate about the origin of the IEDs as well as the intention behind planting IEDs at the specific location and further to take appropriate action against the unknown/unidentified miscreants involved in the planting of IEDs.
5. Therefore it is requested to initiate appropriate action against unknown/unidentified miscreants under the following provisions:-
  - (a) Section 4 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908 (punishment for attempt to cause explosion, or for making or keeping explosive with intent to endanger life or property).
  - (b) Section 286 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Neglect conduct with respect to explosive substance).
  - (c) Section 506(2) of Indian Penal Code (Criminal intimidation, if threat be to cause death or grievous hurt).
