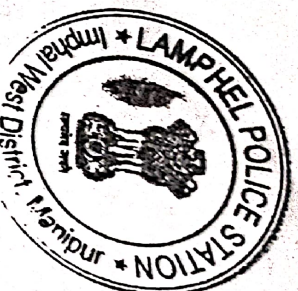

Subject: Enquiry Report

Ref: UD Case No. 6/LPS/2024 u/s 174 Cr.P.C.

Sir,

On 02/04/2024 at 12:15 pm received an information stating that on the same day at about 12: 05 pm one Ritesh Kumar was found dead inside his rented room at Chingmeirong Mamang Leikai near Panthoibi Laishang.

Hence a UD Case under UD No. 6/LPS/2024 u/s 174 Cr. PC has been registered for investigation.

After registered the case, OC/LPS has endorsed me to look into the matter. Accordingly I have investigated the UD case and submitting the inquiry report to OC Lamphel PS which is as follows:-

That , during the course of investigation, visited at the scene of Crime and kept it cordon until the mobile forensic unit team had reached there. The team of, Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West have inspected the spot.

That, the PO was established at the rented house of RK (O) Memcha Devi (60) yrs. W/o Late, RK Amusara of Chingmeirong Mamang leikai near Panthoibi Laishang. The occurrence of the crime was situated at 2nd room counted from western side . There are four room in a row. The room has one door and one window. The lock of the door was opened from outside while panel of the door was closed. When opening the door, things and items were scattered in disarranged manner.

That, the dead body was established as Ritesh Kumar Magar (39)yrs. S/o (L) Nandalal Magar of Namdulong Stadium Road Imphal East, Manipur. His dead body was found lying on the bed, right side lateral position, in a foldable mosquito net. Mouth was opened and tongue was bitten between the teeth, eyes were closed, saliva stain discharged was observed from the mouth and nostril. Discharge of Salvia Stain was also observed on the bed where the mouth was placed. Discharge of Semen was also observed. Right leg was fully bent while left leg was partially bent. Discharge of (chunni) was observed tied around the neck with knots at the back side of the neck.

That, The body was found wearing blue & white stripped full shirt, black half pant black shocks and red underwear.

That, at the time of spot inspection the wife of the deceased was found missing.

That, , the inquest over the dead body was conducted by Mobile Forensic Unit team, and later the dead body was brought to RIMS Morgue and deposited for Post Mortem Examination. On next day i.e 03/04/2024 Post Mortem examination was conducted by an expert team of

Department of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology of RIMS Hospital, Lamphelpat led by Dr. S. Elizabeth,

in presence of an Executive Magistrate Imphal East, and under a video coverage for the Post Mortem Examination.

That, Some of the witnesses, who had been staying together in the same rented house, but at different rooms were examined carefully. They stated that both husband and wife were quarrelling in that night before they were going to bed. They did not try to prevent/ stop their quarrelling because most of the time, the husband and the wife used to quarrel whenever they were in the rented house. Being late night, no one felt like to enter to prevent their quarrelling and people were getting tired, felt sleep. Moreover, they were quarrelling in Nepali Language that was why people did not know for what matter/reason husband wife were quarrelling. Next day, in the morning the wife of the deceased was found missing.

That, on 17/04/2024, a Crime scene Investigation Report No. 22(04)2024 /MFU-IW/Strangulation dated 15/04/2024 in c/w UD No. 06/LPS/2024 U/S 174 Cr.PC dated 02/04/2024 has been received from Forensic Unit Imphal West by OC/LPS. In this report it is opined that "from the observation, death could be ante Mortem and caused by strangulation, homicidal in nature."

That, From the time of Spot inquiry, the wife of the said deceased person has been found missing till date. She never comes out to be present in any ritual ceremony for her husband death.

In this circumstances there is high suspicion that his wife, namely Aphi Makang (not Known Exactly).W/o Ritesh Kumar has committed the offence of killing her husband. And there is a need for proper investigation by registering a regular FIR case.

I therefore requested kindly to register a case against the accused Aphi Makang as to enable to complete a smooth investigation of the case at the end of the justice.
