Sir,

With due respect, I have the honour to report that on 21/06/2024 at about 11.00 am, one unknown person came into my jewellery shop located at Sana Keithel, Lamphel and asked to buy 2 (two) sana san (gold) in order to make jewels for his wife. He said that he will make the payment of Rs. 45,600/- for the amount of the gold through Gpay by one of his friend and asked to provide my GPay No. Accordingly, I have shared my GPay No. 9856105329 to him. Then, he call an unknown person (his friend) for sending the money and then a message was received regarding the payment on my Gpay Account. However, on further checking my GPay account it was found to be only a texted message which read as "Rs. 45,600/-" and the payment was never credited to my Gpay account. After taking the gold, he left the shop. Later, the fraudsters might have blocked or deactivated their GPay account and hence GPay no. could not be established.

The fraudsters have cheated me by sending forged messages of money transaction on the pretext of buying gold.

I therefore request you to kindly look into the matter and help me in retrieving my lost money.
