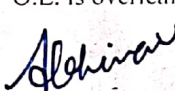

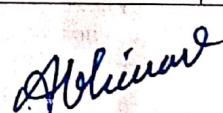

Sir,

I the undersigned have the honour to report that today i.e. 16th April, 2024 at around 6:00 am received a reliable information from 5/9 G.R. regarding the presence of miscreants hideouts between the Aigejang village (Tingkai Khunou) and Irengbam Maning. The same was corroborated from our own source. Accordingly at around 7:00 am, a combined team of 5/9 GR, 16th SSB led by Pankaj Yadav, Asstt. Comdt., a team of Nambol PS and Bishnupur CDO teams led by Sub. Y. Sakti Shen, OC-CDO/BPR, assisted by SI. N. Nandalal Singh, SI. Ph. Sunil Singh, H/C Y. Shanta Singh, Hav. Kh. Kunje Singh in presence of Executive Magistrate Shri Bijoy Nongmaithem, SDC, Oinam, under the overall supervision of Ksh. Ravikumar Singh, IPS, SP/Bishnupur and Amarjit Lamabam, MPS Addl. SP (Ops) Bishnupur conducted a thorough and extensive search operation at the adjoining foothill area between Aigejang village and Irengbam Maning. During the search 3 (three) gunny bags were found concealed in the Nala. On opening the above mentioned bags the following war like store were recovered:

1. 1(one) carbine b/no. 15228731 AF1992 with one empty magazine marked as 124/3.
2. 1(one) flare Pistol b/no. P782235.
3. 2 (two) nos. of pistol b/regd. No. nil with 3 empty magazines.
4. 1 (one) Revolver marked as LC No. K2540.
5. 1(one) IED weighing about 1.4 Kg.
6. 1(one) PEK IED bomb.
7. 4(four) nos. of No 36 HE Hand Grenades without detonators marked as 36 M MK1-1994 (2 nos.) & 36 M MK1-1998 (2 nos.).
8. 24 (twenty four) nos. of HE detonators.
9. 16 (sixteen) nos. of IED fuse.
10. 12 (twelve) nos. of 7.62 ammns. chargers.
11. 5 (five) nos. of .303 ammns. chargers.
12. 1 (one) no. of 36 HE Hand Grenade lever.
13. 8 (eight) nos. of USA Carbine ammns. chargers.
14. 2 (two) nos. of empty magazine of AK-47.
15. 52 (fifty two) nos. of 5.3 mm USA Carbine live rounds.
16. 55 (fifty five) nos. of 7.62 live rounds.
17. 5 (five) nos. of ballistic cartridges.
18. 2 (two) nos. of Tube Launchers with 2 rings.
19. 1 (one) Morse key CW Key for IED.
20. 1(one) remote control (off white colour) of IED.
21. 2(two) walkie talkie of Motorola marked as GP328&GP2000.
22. 1(one) ICOM walkie talkie SL.No.121695.
23. 7(seven) nos. of cleaning rode of unknown weapon.
24. 3(three) nos. 21 HE mortar shell (unknown shell).
25. 1(one) no. of 51HE mortar shell.
26. 2(two) nos. of 2 inch smoke shell.
27. 1(one) no. of 2 inch mortar illumination shell.
28. 3(three) nos. of 2 inch empty smoke shell containers.

The above mentioned items which were suspected to be hidden by miscreants were seized at 8:30 am in presence of the Executive Magistrate by observing formalities and handed over to Nambol PS for further necessary action.
