I have the honour to report you that on 28/10/2024 at about 9.00 pm, a joint team of PGCI PS led by SI. N. Devdas Singh assisted by ASI Md. Ziaul Haque under the command of Inspt. Subhashchandra Konthoujam, OC/PGCI-PS and a team of 19th Garhwal Rifle led by Major Pradhan were on routine frisking & checking in c/w the present prevailing law and order situation at Terakhong Bazar. During frisking and checking, one male youth pedestrian was coming in a very suspicious manner from Pangal Lamkhai side towards Terakhong Bazar. Immediately, the frisking party stopped and detained him for verification. On verification, he identified himself as Md. Hesamuddin (48) yrs S/o (L) Hafijuddin of Kwakta Ward No.1 (KMC). On being suspicious in his manner, he was asked whether he would like to be searched his body before Executive Magistrate or Gazetted officer. On that he opted that his personal search may be conducted in presence of Executive Magistrate. Accordingly, information was passed to Hemam Ricky, Executive Magistrate Moirang to be present at the spot i.e. Terakhong Bazar. Thereafter, the arrival of Executive Magistrate we started checking his body in presence of him and found 6 (six) bottles containing of Codeine Phosphate similarly mark as CC COUGH-T were detected concealing inside his Jacket pocket. Accordingly, the same bottles were seized by observing formalities at 10.35 pm and it was put inside one transparent polythene and marked it as 'A' for identification. Later, he was arrested from the spot at 10.50 pm of the same day by observing all due formalities. The said procedure was done before the Executive Magistrate in presence of volunteers of All Meitei Pangal Youth Association, Kwakta and they also supported that the said detainee is a drug retailer as well as abuser. On further preliminary questioning, he disclosed that 137 more bottles of the same Codeine Phosphate were kept concealed in his premises/ house. Immediately, the same team rushed at the residence of the accused person. On arrival, conducted house searched and found 137 bottles of Codeine Phosphate which were kept concealed inside one plastic sack (marked it as 'B' for identification) and another 35 empty bottles of Codeine Phosphate inside one green colour plastic dustbin (marked it as 'C' for identification) were also recovered at instance and pointing of the accused person. Accordingly, the recovered Items were seized by observing due formalities on 28/10/2024 at 11:15 pm. The transparent polythene containing 6 bottles of Codeine Phosphate marked as 'A' and 137 bottles of Codeine Phosphate marked as 'B' were wrapped together with one white cloth and it was sealed and marked as 'D'. The seized items along with the arrested accused person were brought to PS and handed over to OC/PGCI-PS for further necessary legal procedure.

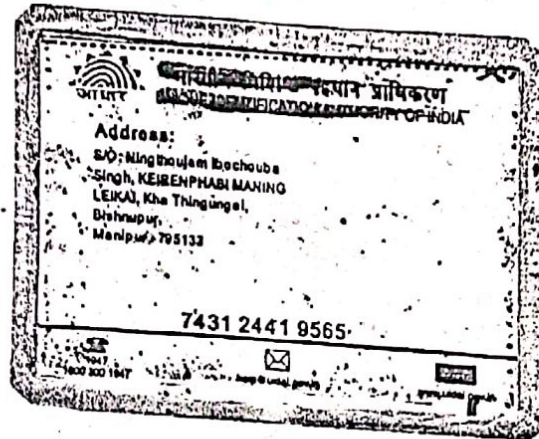
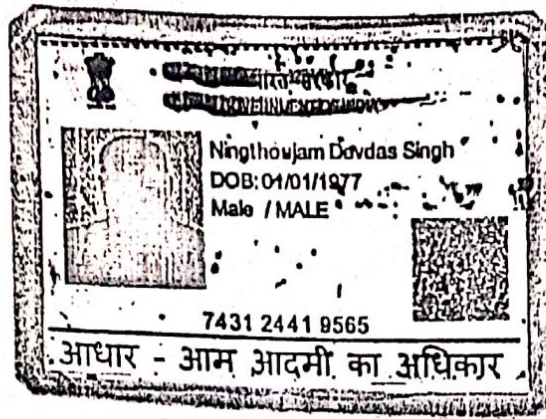
