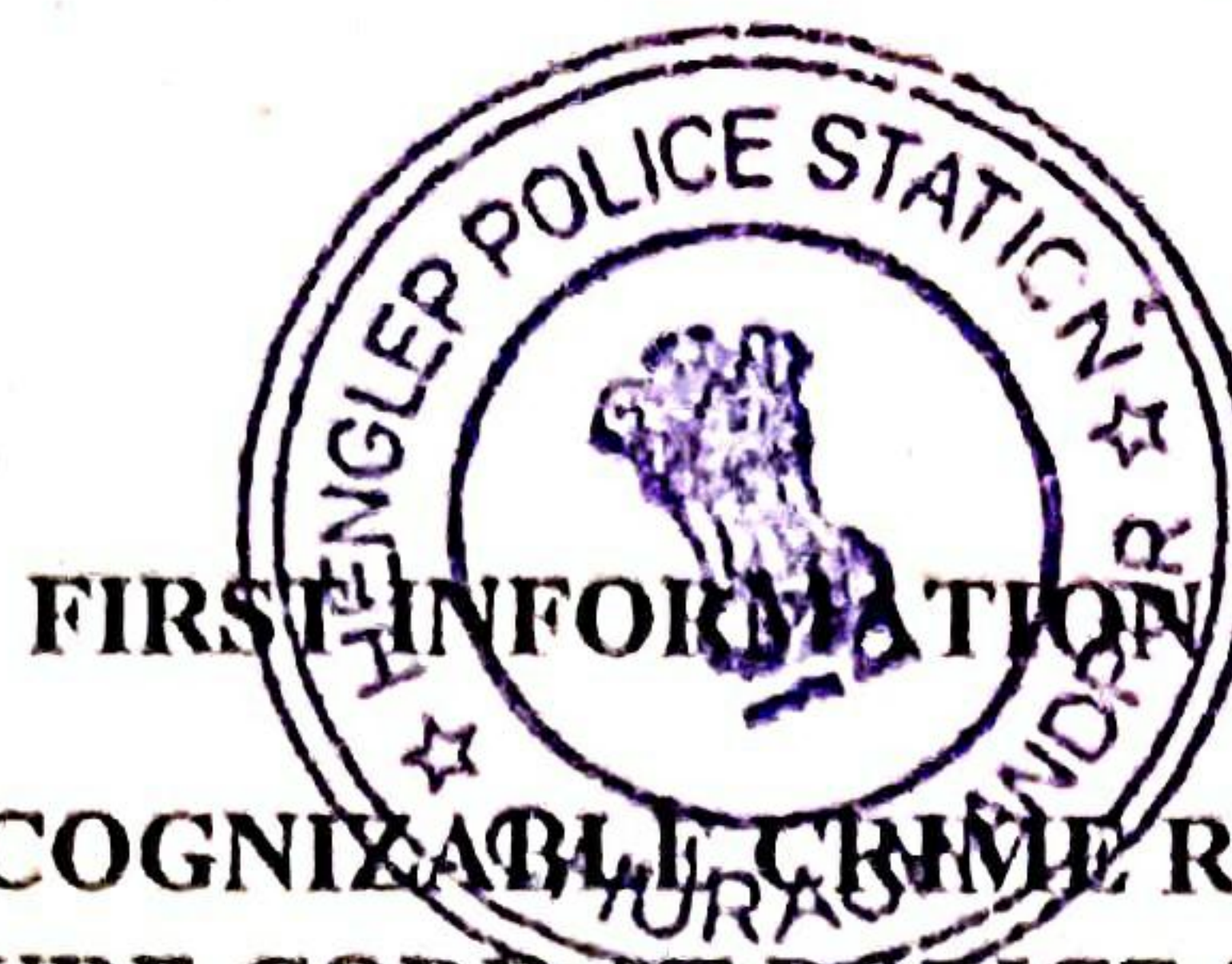

Subject: Report.

Sir,

On 13-03-2024, received information from local populace that some persons had trespassed into Temporary Operating Base (TOB) of 36-Assam Rifles at Muolhoiching, Aina village. So, a column of 36-AR led by self, rushed to the said location at around 1930 hrs of the same day. On reaching there, one TATA vehicle bearing registration no. MZ01S 9137 loaded with the undernoted items, that belongs to the vacated AR Camp, Muolhoiching, was found with 3 persons on board the vehicle. On questioning the three persons namely (i) Mr. Sabur Ahmed (33), (ii) Mr Babul Hussain (29) and (iii) Mr Kamrul Ali (20), they stated that they were stopped by 6 (six) unknown miscreants, one of whom was armed, at about 30 Kms from Santing towards Thanlon and asked them to carry their properties, saying they are men of Electricity Deptt., They refused to cooperate. However, the miscreants coerced them to cooperate. So, they cooperated unwillingly due to fear. On arriving at Muolhoiching, the miscreants loaded the stolen electrical items into the vehicle.

On knowing the arrival of AR column, the miscreants fled away leaving behind one NTORQ Scooty, and the stolen properties loaded in the vehicle.

So, the stolen properties-

1. Generator (small) – 01 no.
- (2). Electric Pole – 23 nos.
- (3). Iron Picket – 28 nos.
- (4). Electric Aluminium Wire – 15 Rolls.
- (5). Solar Pole – 02 nos., and
- (6) One NTORQ scooty, left behind by the miscreants, were seized at the spot.

Further, on verification of properties in the camp, the following items were found missing/stolen away.

- (1). Solar Plate – 4 nos.
- (2). CGI Sheet – 35 nos.
- (3). Iron Pole (supporting temporary barrack) – 3 nos.

The recovered items along with the rescued three persons are herewith handed over to you, for taking up necessary legal action against the 6 unknown miscreants.
