- Today on 13 Aug 2024, based on receipt of specific information reliable source regarding movement of miscreants/cadres in general area saikul Ridge (Dampi Ridgeline). A search operation was launched with effect from 0400 hrs to 0830 hrs by Column of 2 MAHAR and two teams of Churachandpur Police. Detailed search of ridgeline was carried out alongwith police representatives and led to recovery of following weapons and other war like stores:-
