- I wish to bring to your attention regarding the Recovery of an improvised Explosive Device (IED) in Kaprang village, NH-2, churachandpur district, Manipur
- On 31 March 2025, at 1000 hrs information regarding the presence of an IED was received from local sources and was further corroborated by an intelligence agency. Acting upon the input, a joint operation was launched by 36 Assam Rifles, 261 CEDU (Bomb Squad) and Churachandpur Police.
- Upon reaching the location, the area was cordoned off by team of Assam Rifles while the IED was successfully deactivated by the Bomb Disposal teams of 261 CEDU . The operation was conducted meticulously to ensure the safety of local residents and security personnel. The IED was successfully deactivated and recovered at 1215 hrs on 31 Mar 2025.
- Items recovered from the site :-  
(a) 19 x Gelatine Sticks (125 grams each) i.e. 2.375 Kgs.

1. I wish to bring to your attention regarding the recovery of an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) in Kaprang village, NH-2, Churachandpur district, Manipur.
2. On 31 March 2025, at 1000 Hrs information regarding the presence of an IED was received from local sources and was further corroborated by an intelligence agency. Acting upon the input, a joint operation was launched by 36 Assam Rifles, 261 CEDU (Bomb Squad) and Churachandpur Police.
3. Upon reaching the location, the area was cordoned off by team of Assam Rifles while the IED was successfully deactivated by the Bomb Disposal teams of 261 CEDU.
