I have the honour to report that on 11/04/2025, a reliable source input was received stating that some miscreants had concealed a huge cache of arms and ammunition in the fringe areas of Saiton Khunou and Saiton Heiyaikon following the imposition of (PR). The source further confirmed that the miscreants were planning to retrieve the cache with the intent to incite violence and create unrest in the area.

Acting promptly on the input, a joint search operation was launched by a combined team comprising personnel from PGCI PS led by Inspt Subhaschandra Konthoujam OC/PGCI-PS assisted by self, two teams of CDO/BPR (Q67 led by Hav No. 1299329 Ksh Khorongam Chiru and Q83 led by HC K. Bidyashwor Singh), one column of 19 Garhwal Rifles led by Major Amit Kumar and one section of G/71 CRPF led by Assistant Commandant Werilo Lasuh under the supervision of Shri Ksh. Ravikumar Singh, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Bishnupur District and Shri Amarjit Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops) Bishnupur. The team was also equipped with an IED detection dog and metal detector equipment.

The operation was conducted in the adjoining areas of Saiton Khunou and Saiton Haiyaikon. During a thorough search of the area, the IED detection dog signalled the presence of an IED concealed within bamboo bushes. 

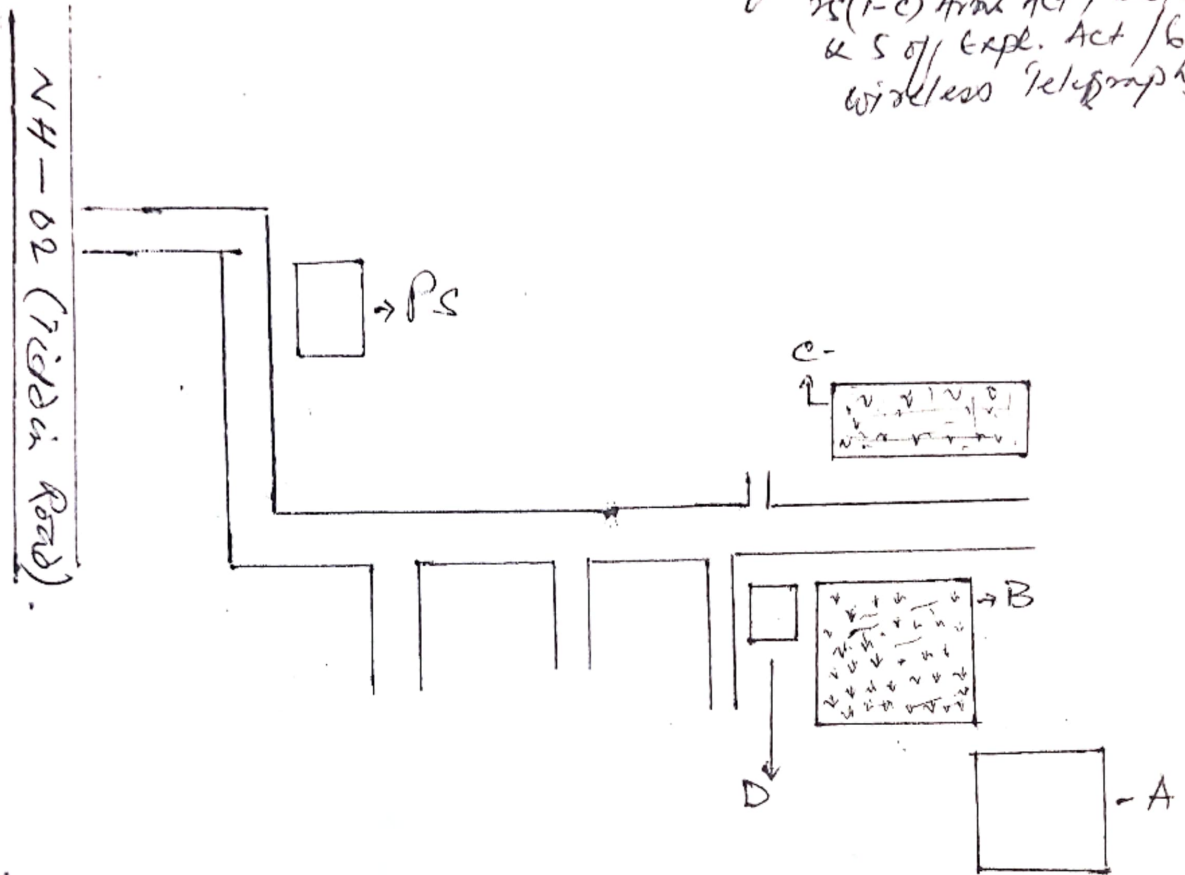


Rough Sketch Map:



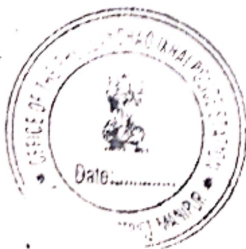
