Subject: Report

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e. the 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 at around 05:30 a.m. while I was at Singjamei Police Station, one of my source men came and informed me that, two women passengers of a fourwheeler passenger vehicle Force Trax Cruiser bearing registration No. AS11FC-0979 will be transporting some quantities of Heroin powder No. 4 in two air bags from Imphal to Jiribam and that the vehicle will be passing through Sagolband Salam Leikai area. Accordingly, I recorded the statement of the source man and reduced in writing and a copy of the source report also has been submitted to SI IW Manipur through OC Singjamei PS for necessary action. Then, I along with police personnel including women police of Singjamei Police Station under the command of Inspt. Sanayaima Sadokpam, OC-SJM-PS and under the supervision of Shri. L. Santos MPS SDPO SJM rushed to the said area and remained there watching for the Narcotic drugs transporter. Meanwhile, one four-wheeler vehicle (Force Trax Cruiser) suspected to be the vehicle mentioned by the source which was plying from Imphal to Jiribam bearing registration no. AS11FC 0979 was seen coming towards our team and stopped the said vehicle at Sagolband Salam Leikai. Two women passengers who were inside the said four-wheeler passenger vehicle were detained there for verification. On verification they identified themselves as (i) Babycha (30) w/o Mohd. Yaras of Hatta, Porompat, I/E and (ii) Dolaipabam Sahani (25) c/o Dolaipabam Ibungo of Mayang Imphal Bengoon Yangbi. Thereafter, I disclosed them about my identity and informed that I have discrete information that they are carrying (Narcotics drugs) Heroin No. 4 in bags. On questioning, the detainee no. 1 Babycha (30) w/o Mohd. Yaras of Hatta, Porompat, I/E admitted herself to have possess Heroin No. 4 in her air bags which she produced before us. The two bags are marked as B1 & B2. Further, Babycha disclosed that she along with the other woman Dolaipabam Sahani have brought the said Narcotic drugs Heroin no. 4 for transporting. Further, I have informed and prepared a requisition for the Mobile Forensic team Imphal West to be present while checking and seizing the Narcotic drugs Heroin No. 4. In the meantime, I requested two unknown civilians near the spot to be independent witnesses for search and seizure on which they readily agreed. Accordingly, when the Mobile Forensic team arrive, our team including women police along with Mobile Forensic team Imphal West searched the air bags in presence of the witnesses. While checking the two air bags 13 (thirteen) numbers of soap cases suspected to be containing Narcotic drugs (Heroin No. 4) were found inside the bag (blue) marked as B1 and 12 (twelve) numbers of soap cases suspected to be containing Narcotic drugs (Heroin No. 4) were found inside the bag (grey) marked as B2. The 13 (thirteen) numbers of soap cases found inside the bag marked as B1 were marked as A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, A8, A9, A10, A11, A12, A13 and 12 (twelve) numbers of soap cases found inside the bag B2 were marked as A14, A15, A16, A17, A18, A19, A20, A21, A22, A23, A24 & A25 respectively as parent exhibits in presence of witness for identification. The 25 (twenty-five) soap cases are all homogenous.

After marking, the soap cases were opened one by one with the help of the Mobile Forensic team in the presence of witnesses and found to be containing suspected Heroin No. 4 in transparent plastic bags. The Mobile Forensic team took out a small amount of suspected Heroin No. 4 from one of the transparent plastic bags marked as A1 and tested with their testing kits and on testing it gives positive result for Heroin No. 4. Each of the plastic bags were weighed by using field scale balance in presence of Mobile Forensic team, IW and witnesses and each packet from the 25 (twenty-five) numbers of soap case which were marked A1 to A25 were found to be containing 10.72 gm, 13.11 gm, 12.41 gm, 13.95 gm, 12.17 gm, 12 gm, 12.57 gm, 13.67 gm, 12 gm, 12.07 gm, 13.26 gm, 12.45 gm, 11.51 gm, 12.13 gm, 12.30 gm, 12.89 gm, 12.32 gm, 12.99 gm, 11.55 gm, 11.70 gm, 13.39 gm, 11.92 gm, 11.75 gm, 11.80 gm & 11.52 gm respectively in total weighed 308.15 gm including the weight of the plastic and excluding the weight of the soap cases. The detected 25 (twenty-five) numbers of soap cases containing Heroin No. 4, one realme Note 8 smart phone bearing mobile no 9362840519 & two air bags were seized on production by Babycha (30) w/o Mohd. Yaras of Hatta, Porompat, I/E at the spot at 9:10 am in presence of the witnesses by observing formalities. One Nokia Keypad mobile phone bearing mobile no 8787351890 was seized at 9:15 am on production by Dolaipabam Sahani (25) c/o Dolaipabam Ibungo of Mayang Imphal Bengoon Yangbi in presence of the witnesses. The 25 (twenty-five) numbers of soap cases containing heroin No. 4 were wrapped with a white cloth and packed and sealed and marked as C in presence of the witnesses. Thus, they were arrested from the spot at 9:18 am & 9:20 am respectively of the same day by observing formalities. I, the arrested persons and the witnesses put signatures on the seizure memos and the arrest memos.

The arrested persons and the seized items are handed over to you for taking up further necessary action against them.
