Subject: Request to lodge a Police Complaint Related to the Bomb Threat E-mail received at Officer-In-Charge Aero. Imphal And PGO Imphal From an unknown E-Mail ID

Please find enclosed a copy of the email dated 29.06.2025, received from an unknown email ID (roadkillandkyokill@atomicmail.io) (Copy enclosed)

In this regard, it is informed that on 29.06.2025 at 1018 Hrs, a bomb threat email was received by the Officer-in-Charge, AERO and PGO, AAI Imphal, from the aforementioned

unidentified email address. The same email was also sent to several other airports. For your reference, the redrafted content of the message is as follows:

1. Powerful explosive devices have been hidden inside backpacks placed around the airport.
2. The buildings must be evacuated immediately.
3. Immediate action is necessary, or people inside will die, lose limbs, or suffer decapitation.
4. We, "Roadkill" and "Kyo", are responsible for this terror attack.
5. This message must be shared with news outlets.

As per the Standard Operating Procedure, a Bomb Threat Assessment Committee (BTAC) meeting was convened at the Arrival Conference Hall of Imphal Airport, where the contents of the email were reviewed. The BTAC members assessed the threat as **Non-Specific**.

Nevertheless, the committee decided to implement the actions listed under Box 5 of the Bomb Warning Assessment Form and to file a formal complaint with the local police authorities.
