

I have the honour to report that today i.e. the 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 at about 4:30 a.m. received an information from a reliable source about the concealment of a nos. of arms, ammunitions and explosives by unknown arms miscreants in general area of N P Khullen Village of Imphal East District. Based on the said information, a combined team of CDO, Imphal East Unit and a column of 5/9 GR under the command of Inspt. Kh. Henery Singh, OC-CDO/IE Unit and under the supervision of Shri. Y. Joyraj Singh, MPS Addl. SP(Ops) Imphal East District conducted a searched operation in the general area of N P Khullen Village and its adjoining areas of Imphal East District at about 5:00 a.m.

During the search operation, four nos. of sack bags were found lying abandoned at a foothill, which is about 1 Km away at the western side of NP Khullen Village, Imphal-East. On opening the sack bags, the undernoted arms, ammunitions and explosives were found and recovered;
