S. Birla Singh, OC/CDO unit, Kakching, a team of HLM-PS led by Smt. Khundrakpam Hemabati, MPS i/c, OC/HLM-PS and one platoon of "B Coy" 18 Bn. BSF led by Inspector Raviraj Tomar under the Supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, MPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching District. During the Search Operation the area was cordoned off and search was conducted at suspected area.
