REQUISITION FOR FIRST INFORMATION REPORT

1. Background. Post OP Belam Veng on 20 February 25, when the Home Secretary of Chin Kuki Mizo Army (CKMA), a non SoO Group, Mangsei Guite was apprehended, intelligence on Paolen Guite was surfaced and it was revealed that Paolen Guite is the self styled Commander-in- Chief of CKMA and kingpin of drug trade and weapon trafficking from across the Myanmar-India for non SoO Groups. Additionally, through the mobile phone of Seiminlen Dounge, Finance Secretary of United Kuki National Army(UKNA), a non SoO group, post his apprehension on 16 Feb 25, it was learnt that Paolen is instrumental in arming the UKNA Group as well. Since then, Paolen Guite was palced under continuous track and surveillance.

1.1 Details about Paolen Guite.

1.1.1. Paolen Guite is a prominent insurgent leader from Mongjang village in Churachandpur District. He rose to prominence in 2023 after raising an insurgent group called Indo-Myanmar Border Village Volunteer (IMBVV). It was raised to control the Narcotics trade routes between Myanmar & Manipur.

1.1.2. Its member included locals from Mongzang and those displaced from Sugnu areas after the ethnic clashes in May 23. The first batch of IMBVV cadres passed out in Aug 23 with around 50-70 cadre. For this batch, Paolen Guite procured approx. 10 automatics weapons (Including AK-47s, M4 carbines) from Myanmar.

1.1.3. By mid-2024, he recruited more cadres and conducted training of second batch. Additional automatic weapons and ammunition were procured from Myanmar to enhance the muscle power of the group.

1.1.4. With strength rose to 100-120 cadres equipped with 30-40 automatics, Paolen Guite renamed the group as Chin Kuki Mizo Army (CKMA).

1.1.5. During the CM's convoy attack on 10 Jun 24, he was instrumental in supplying weapons and War Like Stores to UKNA who executed the attack. He was also involved in the Jiribam Killings of innocent civilians in Nov 24. Thereafter he fled Manipur and inputs of him operating drug business from Tripura and Mizoram recd.

1.1.6. After apprehension of Mangsei Guite in Feb 25, he fled to Myanmar from Mizoram being suspicious of his arrest. He went complete underground till Jun 25.

1.1.7. His involvement again received in the killings of five CKMA cadres (their names are Paulinsei @ Ethan, Seikholam @ Alex, Mangkholen @ Ringo, Lunminlal @ Rambo & Thanglenmang @ Pongba) in Jul 25 at K Daveijang, Village in Noney District which he ordered himself. He killed three members of the Zou community (their names are David and Gogou of S Muvanlai Village, Churachandpur District and Mr Fighter of Kangpokpi District) in Aug 25 to show his dominance and incite terror amongst the local populace.

1.1.8. In Sep 25, he publicly declared full support to UKNA. He went to Henglep-Songkong in mid Sep 25 and met Thangmang alias Alex, Self Styled Commander – in- Chief of UKNA to divide the area between UKNA and CKMA for extortion and drug trafficking. Post his meeting with Alex, he has planned a merger with UKNA in order to get support of UKNA and operate in Churachandpur District.

1.2 **Surveillance & Tracking.** On 03 Jun 2025, during OP Kerith, four CKMA cadres were apprehended in a successful intelligence based operation and from them mobile no of Paolen's driver was recovered. Through TECHINT & HUMINT, it was revealed that the driver has a girlfriend in Churachandpur Town and he comes to visit her occasionally, though concealed. Through his driver, Paolen's personal vehicle Black Thar was identified. Multiple operation in Aug 25, however, he managed to escape.

1.3 Operation Launch.

1.3.1. On 25 Sep 25, input again received that Paolen's driver has been spotted in Churachandpur town and he has come to meet his girlfriend. He deliberately attempted to hide his movements which raised suspicion that a high profile cadre, likely Paolen Guite, is in Churachandpur town. TECHINT and HUMINT and own sources further confirmed the presence of Paolen Guite.

1.3.2. Multiple columns were launched discreetly ex 37 Assam Rifles with effect from 26 Sep 25 from Khuga to track and apprehend Paolen Guite. Dynamic Mobile Vehicle Check Posts(MVCPs) were also launched to prevent egress of him from the town.

1.3.3. Finally, on 30 Sep 25, based on hard intelligence (both TECHINT & HUMINT), location of Paolen was identified where he was hiding along with his bodyguard. Immediately, OPS MUNUAM was launched by Column ex 37 Assam Rifles at 1730 Hr 30 Sep 25.

1.3.4. Column Commander conducted a meticulous cordon and deployed stops to prevent escape while maintaining surprise. At 0130 Hr 01 Oct 25, search commenced on the identified house. On sighting security forces, Paolen and his bodyguard armed with weapons attempted escape from the window of the house using cover of darkness.

1.3.5. Seeing their escape, Column Commander along with his Quick Reaction Team (QRT) chased them through the built up area. With full concern to safety of civilians in the village, Column Commander ensured minimal use of force and effective fire control. With utter disregard to own safety, Column Commander ensued chase of approx. 1.5 km.

1.3.6. When observing apprehension, Paolen Guite attempted to Open fire from his AK-47 to prevent arrest, however, Column Commander snatched the AK-47 rifle and physically overpowered him after hand- to- hand fight. While the Column Commander was physically overpowering Paolen Guite, his bodyguard managed to escape leaving his weapon behind.

1.4. Further search of the house led to recovery of various kind of ammunition, bullet proof pouch, cash. Mobile phones and a Hyundai Creta Vehicle.

1.5. The operation concluded with the successful apprehension of Paolen Guite Self Styled Commander-in- Chief of CKMA along with two automatic weapons and ammunition. This operation has given a significant blow to the entire CKMA group and their

operations in Manipur.

2. Impact of the operation.

2.1. Disruption to cross Border Drug Trafficking. The Mynamar linked drug network that is controlled by Paolen single handedly will be significantly disrupted, thereby giving a major blow to drug nexus which is used to fund cadres both in hills and valley.

2.2. Non SoO Groups Arming. The arming of Non SoO Groups incl UKNA will be curtailed, thereby limiting the strengthening of any such group.

2.3. Leadership Vacuum. With Paolen detained the CKMA command structure will be rudderless, thereby degrading their overall influence and operations.

2.4. UKNA Destabilisation. UKNA'S arms support is being provided by Paolen and with his arrest, their plans and operation will be adversely affected.

2.5. Illegal Financial Network. His arrest will reveal potential financial networks active in Manipur that funds insurgency and weapons & drug trafficking. This will be a major blow to the insurgent network operating in the entire NE India.




