Today i.e., 27/08/2025 at about 12.10 pm, while I was on duty at Keishampat Junction in c/w the 60th Hunger Marchers Day observation rally organized by AMSU, one of my private source men informed me that, two vehicles i.e., one Tata Nexon white in colour B/Regn No. NL07H-9313 and Maruti Alto car white in color B/Regn. no. NL077CC -1261 are transporting a huge consignment of contraband drugs by concealing inside the body of one of the said two vehicles. The vehicles are on the way along Mayai Lambi and arriving soon at Keishampat Junction. Accordingly, I have recorded the statement of the source man and reduced it into writing and a similar copy of the source report has submitted to SP-IW for necessary proceedings. Then, a team of Imphal PS under the command of SDPO-Imphal under the overall supervision of Shri, Ksh. Shivakanta Singh, IPS, SP-IW has been deployed at Keishampat Junction and started look out for the said Tata Nexon and Maruti Alto car. At about 12.40 PM, the said vehicles were seen coming towards Keishampat Junction along Mayai Lambi. Immediately our police team stopped the vehicles for checking and verification in front of Yumsha Chicken Centre while the vehicles were stopped for traffic clearance. The driver of the Tata Nexon white in color B/Regn No. NL07H9313 was identified as one S. Davihao Mikrii (21 yrs) S/O Sahriini of Laii Village, PO-Tadubi, PS-Tungjoy, Senapati, Manipur and the driver of the Maruti Alto car white in color B/regn no. NL077CC-1261 was identified as Ngaoloni (48 yrs) S/O Kho of Laii Village, PO-Tadubi, PS-Tungjoy, Senapati, Manipur. On spot verification, I informed them that I have a discrete information that they are carrying contraband Narcotics drugs by concealing inside the Tata Nexon white in colour B/Regn No. NLO7H-9313. But they denied the charge of carrying contraband drugs. In the meantime, the detainee namely S. Davihao Mikrii stealthily threw away his mobile phone at the drain at Keishampat junction and it became more and more suspicious. Because of the heavy traffic congestion at Keishampat Junction due to the rally the detainees along with their vehicles were brought at Jail road Old Lambulane in front of Income Tax Office for a thorough search. On arrival at Jail road, immediately, I informed and submitted a requisition for the Mobile Forensic unit, Imphal West to be present and assist in checking and seizing the Narcotic drugs. In the meantime, I also submitted a requisition to the DM Imphal West to depute an Executive Magistrate to present while checking and seizing the Narcotic drugs. Thereafter, the Executive magistrate and Mobile Forensic Team, FSL Imphal West along with one hired car mechanic arrived at the spot. Two civilians (including the car mechanic) near the spot were also readily agreed to be the independent witnesses for search and seizure. Accordingly, our police team in presence of Shri. N. Ingocha Singh, MPS, SDPO-Imphal, the Executive Magistrate and witnesses with the assistance of Mobile Forensic team Imphal West searched both the vehicles. While checking the vehicles, 30 (thirty) nos. of soap cases suspected to have been containing contraband Narcotic drugs were found inside the right side running board of the said Tata Nexon white in colour B/Regn No. NL07H-9313 driven by S. Davihao Mikrii. On further questioning, they admitted that the contraband Narcotics drugs were transporting from Chandel to Dimapur via Mayai Lambi. They also admitted that the Alto car driven by Ngaoloni was escorting the Tata Nexon car.

Accordingly marked the 30 nos. of the said soap cases as A1 to A30 in presence of the witnesses for identification. The 30(thirty) nos. of soap cases are all homogenous in nature. After marking, the soap cases were opened one by one with the assistance of the Mobile Forensic Unit in the presence of independent witnesses, Executive Magistrate and Shri. N. Ingocha Singh, MPS, SDPO-Imphal. The soap cases are found to be

containing suspected heroine/brown sugar in transparent plastic pouch. The Mobile Forensic team took out a small amount of suspected brown sugar from 30 nos. of soap cases with an interval of 5 and tested with their testing kits and on testing it gives positive result for heroine/brown sugar. Each of the plastic pouch/soap cases were marked again as A1 to A30 and on weighing by using electronic weighing machine in presence of the two independent witnesses, Shri. N. Ingocha Singh, MPS, SDPO-Imphal with the assistance of Mobile Forensic Unit, IW and Executive Magistrate found weighing as A1-11gm, A2-11gm, A3-11gm, A4-11gm, A5-11gm, A611gm, A7-11gm, A8-11gm, A9-11gm, A10-12gm, A11-11gm, A12-11gm, A13-11gm, A14-11gm, A15- 12 gm, A16-14gm, A17-11gm, A18-11gm, A19-11gm, A20-10gm, A21-11gm, A22-11gm, A23-11gm, A24-12gm, A25-12gm, A26-12gm, A27-12gm, A28-12gm, A29-12gm & A30-11gm including the weight of its plastic pouch and without the weight of the soap cases. Thus, a total weight of suspected brown sugar is found 341 gm approximately while that of each empty soap cases in total is found 27 gm approximately. The detected 30(thirty) numbers of soap cases suspected to be containing heroine/brown sugar powder were kept inside one cartoon box and packed and sealed by using Facsimile of OC/Imphal-PS and marked as "A" and seized the same from the unauthorized possession of S. Davihao Mikrii by observing formalities at 04.30 PM along with 1(one) Tata Nexon (white) b/no. NL07H9313, Chassis No. MAT627201JLE21781 & Engine no. REVTRN03DRYK39130 along with its key, 1(one) Aadhaar card b/no. 828396999201 & 1 (one) Driving licence b/no. MN0820240000669, 1(one) Realme GT7 mobile handset having mobile no. RMX5061, IMEI nos.-860329070164399 & 86039070164381 and fitted with an Airtel SIM card b/no. 8132021599 and 1(one) ACE3 keypad mobile handset having IMEI no. 352339440846992 & 352339449993068 fitted with an Airtel SIM card bearing SIM No.

89911609900 27348890U in presence of the independent witnesses.

Hence, the accused persons S. Davihao Mikrii (21 yrs) S/O Sahriini of Laii Village, PO-Tadubi, PS-Tungjoy, Senapati, Manipur and Ngaoloni (48 yrs) S/O Kho of Laii Village, PO-Tadubi, PS-Tungjoy, Senapati, Manipur were arrested from the spot at 04.50 PM and 04.55 PM respectively of the same day by observing formalities. Further, the seized drugs, vehicles, documents, mobile handsets and the arrested persons were brought at the PS.

Hence, a case under FIR No. 296(08)2025 IPS u/s 21(c)/25/29/60(3) ND&PS Act has been registered against the arrested persons and their accomplices for investigation.
