I have the honour to report that today ie 16/12/2025 from 6 AM, security forces comprising of CCPur Police led by SI Haolensang Singson of CCP-PS, D/157 Bn CRPF led by Asst. Cmdt. Naresh Kumar, B/157 Bn CRPF led by Inspt Satpal Khatana , D/129 Bn CRPF led by Inspt MR Islam, Dett QAT 129 CRPF Bn led by Asst. Cmdt. Sh Sanjay Kumar and D/70 Bn BSF led by Inspt Nem Singh under the supervision of Anil Kumar Singh 2IC, Dett 129 Bn CRPF and Shri Augustine Jangminthang Khongsai, MPS, ASP(Ops)CCP with the overall supervision of SP-CCP conducted joint combing operation at Khaopijang Village under CCP-PS from 6:00 AM. During the combing operation total nos of 15 houses and 45 persons were verified. Further developed reliable sources of the presence of arms concealed at general area of Khaopijang Village Cemetry about 800-1000 metres away from Khaopijang Village. Immediately, the security teams proceeded towards the area, arrived at the spot at around 7:00 AM conducted elaborate searched of the general area. After 30 minutes of searched at around 7:30 AM the following illegal arms

were detected which were concealed under thick bushes and trees highly suspected to be hidden by unknown miscreants. The illegal arms are extracted one by one, the following are the details of the recovered illegal weapons:






