I have the honour to state that on 16th August 2025, at around 9:00 pm, received an information from the volunteers of All-Meitei Pangal Youth Association (AMPYA), a local civil society organisation citing the movement of some unknown persons in and around Kwakta village who are suspected to be involved in drug trafficking. Based on the information, a joint team comprising of myself (SI. Kh Premkumar Singh), Quebec-83, led by Hav. No. 1194122 Md. Rafik of CDO/BPR, Quebec-81 led by Hav. No. 05066546 Md. Burhamuddin of CDO/BPR, a column of 19 Garhwal Rifles conducted frisking and checking at Kwakta Terakhongshangbi Bazar along NH-02 Tiddim road. The frisking and checking were carried out under the command of Inspt. N. Samson Singh OC/PGCI-PS, BPR and under the supervision of Shri Yumnam Premjit Singh, MPS, Addl. SP (L/O), Bishnupur and under the overall guidance of Shri Ksh. Ravikumar Singh, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Bishnupur District, Manipur.

In the meanwhile, one four-wheeler vehicle Maruti Alto Lxi silver colour having registration no. MN 06L 1866 was seen approaching from Kwakta Bazar towards Moirang side in a suspicious manner. Immediately, the police team stopped the car and upon verification, the driver was identified as Md. Najeruddin @ Babu Phisubam aged about 42 years S/o Md. Karimuddin, resident of Kwakta Ward No. 8(KMC), PO-Moirang, PS-Phougakchao Ikhai, Bishnupur District, Manipur and one occupant namely Md. Altab Khan @ Boy Moijingmayum aged about 31 years S/o Md. Mubarak resident of Kwakta Ward No. 8(KMC), PO-Moirang, PS-Phougakchao Ikhai, Bishnupur District, Manipur. Thereafter, I requested two volunteers of AMPYA namely Md. Arif Khan (22 yrs) S/o MV Abdul Hamid of Kwakta Ward No. 2 (GP) and Md. Imtiyaz (25 yrs) S/o Md. Naham of Kwakta Ward No. 1 (KMC) to be civil witness while conducting the legal procedures in which they voluntarily agreed. I felt the need to search the body of both the persons and the vehicle. So, I informed them that they can opt to be searched in presence of either a gazetted officer or an executive magistrate. The same was reduced in writing, read out by translating the content in Manipuri. As per their option to be searched in presence of an executive magistrate, I accordingly intimated to Executive Magistrate Moirang over the phone to be witness for the search on the spot. Upon the arrival of the Executive Magistrate Moirang at the spot, we started searching their four-wheeler vehicle in presence of the civil witness. While in the initial searching of the vehicle, any suspected items could not be found. Thereafter, the vehicle along with both the accused persons were brought to a nearby workshop and thoroughly searched again to which we found 22 nos. of soap cases concealed in the lower additional fuel tank of the vehicle. On opening the soap cases, reddish colour like substance suspected to be Heroin powder were found inside the soap case. The soap cases were marked as A1 upto A22 for identification and on weighing in presence of the civil witness and executive magistrate, Moirang, it was found as A1-12 grams, A2-12 grams, A3-12 grams, A4-12 grams, A5-12 grams, A6-12 grams, A7-12 grams, A8-12 grams, A9-12 grams, A10-12 grams, A11-11 grams, A12-13, A13-12 grams, A14-12 grams, A15-12 grams, A16-12 grams, A17-12 grams, A18-11, A19-12 grams, A20-13 grams, A21- 12 grams and A22-12 grams in total 264 grams respectively excluding the weight of the soap cases. Then, all the soap cases were put into one cartoon box wrapped with white colour marked as "Z" which was properly packed and sealed. On preliminary verification, they disclosed that the 22 nos. of soap cases were brought by them from one unknown lady of Churachandpur District, Manipur for selling to prospective buyers. Accordingly, the 22 soap cases were seized from the possession of both the accused persons namely Md. Najeruddin @ Babu Phisubam and Md. Altab Khan @ Boy Moijingmayum in the

presence of witnesses at 10:52 pm on the same day along with 1(One)four-wheeler vehicle having bearing registration No. MN 06L 1866 and its ignition key, 1(One) smart mobile handset Realme 14X 5G gold colour having mobile No. 6909652119 of Airtel Telecom Pvt. Ltd. and (1)One keypad HMD mobile handset dark grey in colour having mobile no. 7628956098 of Airtel Telecom Pvt. Ltd.

After completing all the formalities, both the accused persons namely Md. Altab Khan @ Boy and Md. Najeruddin @ Babu Phisubam were arrested at 11:03 pm and 11:04 pm respectively from the spot. The arrested individuals and the seized items were then handed over to OC/PGCI-PS for further necessary legal proceedings as per law.
