I have the honour to report that on 18/09/2025 at about 12 :00 p.m. a joint team of PGCI-PS led by myself including woman PC and personnel of 19<sup>th</sup> Garhwal led by Lt. Abhay Kumar Shukla assisted by Sub. Kripal Singh under the command of Inspt. N. Samson Singh, OC/PGCI-PS under the supervision of Shri Yumnam Premjit Singh, MPS, Addl. SP(L/O)/BPR and overall guidance of Shri Ksh. Ravikumār Singh, IPS, SP-BPR were conducting regular frisking and checking at Phougakchao Ikhai Bazar check point along tiddim road. In the meantime, one passenger diesel auto b/reg. no. MN02B-7629 which was coming from Churachandpur towards Kwakta bazaar was stopped for checking. On checking the belonging of the occupants, 10 number of soap cases containing suspected heroine powder were found concealed inside one plastic grey colour carry hand bag. On verification about the ownership of the said carry bag, it was established that the said carry bag containing suspected heroine powder belongs to Farida Begum aged about 36yrs w/o Md. Muhibur Sheikh of Terakhongshangbi G.P. ward no. 1. Further, I asked her that she is suspected to have kept and concealed illegal contrabands items on her body and informed her as per the section of 50 ND&PS Act to be searched her body either in presence of a magistrate or a Gazetted officer. In that she opted that her personal search may be conducted then and there before a Gazetted officer. I then instructed a team member to bring a weighing machine and other printed relevant documents of ND& PS offence kept maintained at the PS Accordingly, I requested the Gazetted officer Shri Chaitanya, IPS, SDPO/MRG to be witness for the search on the spot. On arrival of Chaitanya, SDPO/MRG at the spot, lady police personnel start searching her body in presence of civil witness. However, no further recovery could be made from her body searched. On examination, she disclosed that the soap cases are heroin powder and the said suspected heroin powder handed over by Neng @ Chochong Kipgen aged about 50 years of New

On weighing the said drugs in presence of civil witnesses and gazette officer Chaitanya, IPS, SDPO/MRG, the total weight of the suspected heroin powder was found 153 grams approximate including the weight of transparent plastic polyethene and excluding the weight of the soap cases. For identification, the soap cases were marked as A1-17gms, A2-15gms, A3-13gms, A4- 17gms, A5-14gms, A6-16gms, A7-18gms, A8-13gms, A9-16gms, and A10-14gms.

The 10 (ten) soap cases along with one Infinix mobile phone with JIO sim card bearing mobile no. 9863053828 and one grey colour plastic carry hand bag was seized from the possession of Farida Begum at 12:20pm and later she was arrested at 12:25pm by observing due formalities. Thereafter, the 10 soap cases were packed and sealed after putting inside a cartoon box marked as 'Z' in presence of witnesses. The arrested person along with the seized articles were handed over to OC/PGCI-PS for taking up necessary legal action against her as per law.
