In this regard, a suo-motto enquiry has been initiated and the same was endorsed to me for enquiry.

During the course of enquiry, analyzed the viral video showing the manufacturing of unauthorized cream and lotion and came to know that the place where manufacturing of such unauthorized cream and lotion was done was at the parental residence of one Smt. Kshetrimayum Bonila Devi (32) yrs. W/o I. Prem @ Khaba Singh located at Kakching Moirangthem Leikai, Kakching District, Manipur. As such, the place was visited and searched but no incriminating articles were found at the time of inspection.

In the course of further enquiry, examined Mrs. Bonila Devi and her relatives and came to know that the said cream was ordered through an online shopping apps along with its packaging items. The packaging of such cream was done at her parental house and started selling to the public at an amount of Rs. 1500/- (per piece) after pasting duplicate sticker of 'Dr. James' which she had bought through online shopping apps. It is also learnt that she (Bonila) imported the materials under another cosmetic's name and imitated by using fake manufacturer's name i.e. 'Dr. James'. She hired some persons including her relatives for the purpose of making and packaging the cream and lotion. Besides, she has been falsely advertising through social medial about the products through some of her distributors but she couldn't produce any relevant certified documents regarding the products which she had sold to the public.

Thus, from the enquiry conducted, a prima facie evidence to conduct a full investigation under the charges of 61/125/318(2) BNS & 13(1)(a) Drugs & Cosmetic Act. 1940 are well established and there is need for registering a regular FIR case so that the investigation can be done properly and delve deeper.

So, I am submitting my enquiry report to you for registering a regular FIR case.


