I have the honour to state that today i.e., 19/06/2025 at about 02:20 am, a reliable information was received regarding the presence of some miscreants at Heibonglok Hill area under Sekmai PS. Based on the information, a combined team of 2/8 GR (Indian Army), a team of Sekmai PS and a team of CDO-IW led Inspector Gunachandra Chanam, OC-CDO-IW assisted by Subedar Ch. Surjit Kumar and SI. S. Barun Singh and myself under the command of Shri Gaurav Dogra, IPS, i/c Addl. SP(Ops.)/IW and overall supervision of Shri Ksh. Shivakanta Singh, IPS, SP-IW rushed to the said area and conducted search operation at some suspected areas of Heibonglok Hill (Tingri) from about 03:10 am onwards. During the search operation, the said combined team recovered the undernoted articles which were found abandoned at Heibonglok Hill suspected to be hidden by some unknown miscreants:

- 1) One sack bag wrapping:- (i) one no. of modified No 1 MK 3 .303 Rifle along with one magazine and (ii) one local made single barrel gun.
- 2) One garbage bag blue in colour wrapping one local made single barrel gun with foldable butt.
- 3) A sheet of bubble wrap wrapping one no. of BAOFENG Digital Mobile Radio set.
- 4) One sack bag containing:
  - (i) Three nos. of BP vest (all in green colour) along with six nos. of iron plates (suspected to be used as BP).

- (ii) One no. of BP Patka camouflage in colour.  
 (iii) Two nos. of helmet (one in green colour and another one in camouflage colour).
- 5) One white plastic bag containing:
- (i) One black polythene bag containing: (a) 11 (eleven) nos. of ammunition of .303 Rifle, (b) 10 (ten) nos. 12 Bore Cartridge, (c) one no. of CTG 40 mm HEDP MG-4 Grenade, (d) one no. of CTG 40 mm HE MG-3 Grenade, (e) one no. of No. 36 HE hand grenade without detonator, (f) one Chinese hand grenade and (g) two nos. of detonators.  
 (ii) Three nos. of magazine of 7.62 LMG.  
 (iii) Two nos. of magazine of INSAS LMG.  
 (iv) Two nos. of magazine of INSAS Rifle.
