Nikhil Singh** CDO/IE Unit lodged a written report to OC/APS at 07:15 pm stating that on the same day i.e. the 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2025 at about 5:00 a.m. received a reliable information from our own source corroborated with the intelligence of 165 TA about the concealment of arms, ammunitions and explosive at Yairipok Top Ningthounai Lai Ching and its surrounding foothill area of Imphal-East District. Based on the said information and with the permission/authorization of the authority, a combined team of CDO/IE Unit assisted by Sub. K. Ibungobi Singh of 7<sup>th</sup> IRB/CDO/IE Unit along with a column of 165 TA, 31 AR and 46 AR conducted a search operation at the said area and its surrounding foothill area of Imphal East District under the command of Inspt. Anilchandra Mutum, Officer-in-Charge CDO/IE Unit, supervised by Shri. S. Y. Joyraj Singh, MPS Addl. SP (Ops)IE and under the overall supervision of Shri. Shivanand Surve, IPS, Superintendent of Police Imphal East District at 6:00 a.m.

In that, the undernoted arms, ammunitions and explosives were found hidden in a bush at the foothill of Yairipok Top Ningthounai Lai Ching, Imphal East District.


