Sub: - Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e. 24/12/2025 at about 1:15 pm received reliable information that some contraband items are being transported along NH2 in Sangakpham-Mantripukhri area. The said information was reduced in writing and was placed before Shri Ak. Sadananda Singh, Addl. SP (Traffic) Imphal-East (Nodal Officer ANTF Imphal-East) for executing the information into action.

On approval of the source report, a team of Heingang Police Station led by Officer-in-Charge including myself took positions at Mantripukhri area along NH-2 and conducted random frisking and checking. While doing so, one suspected Maruti Swift car bearing r/no. – AS 01 BE 7900 was spotted coming towards Mantripukhri from Sangakpham side. The said car was then stopped and detained the driver. On asking, the detainee identified himself as one **Md. Mustakim (29 yrs), s/o (L) Md. Yusuf Khan of Mairenkul, Sangaiyumpham Part-1, Thoubal PS, Thoubal District.**

On further examination, the detainee disclosed about 24 (twenty-four) soap cases, containing suspected Heroin No. 4 powder, being kept concealed inside fuel tank of the vehicle (Maruti Swift car bearing r/no. – AS 01 BE 7900) in connivance with one Md. Ibungo, aged about 34 yrs, from Nungphou, Sangaiyumpham Part-1, Thoubal District. So, I told the detainee that his body and belongings needed to be searched. On being asked whether he would like to be searched before a Gazetted Officer or before an Executive Magistrate, he stated that the search can be conducted by me (SI. Ksh. Gyanjit Singh) in presence of an Executive Magistrate and civil witness. Immediately, I contacted the office of the DM/Imphal-East District and accordingly deputed one Executive Magistrate namely Shri. Ningthoujam Ratan Singh, SDC- Heingang/IE, (Magistrate). One civilian present there at spot is requested to witness the search and checking body and belongings of the detainee.

The vehicle Maruti Swift car bearing r/no. – AS 01 BE 7900 along with the detainee was taken to a nearby four-wheeler workshop at Khabam Chumbreithong, IE. Thereafter, in the presence of the Executive Magistrate and one independent witness, body of the detainee was checked. While checking his body, found one mobile phone (POCO black in colour) bearing IMEI Nos. (i) 868331071328181, (ii) 868331071328199 along with one SIM card bearing mobile no. - 9863442864 and one wallet containing a sum of Rs. 720/- (seven hundred and twenty), one AADHAR Card having no. 2141 6275 0479 and one driving license. And on searching the vehicle with the help of mechanics available at the workshop, as pointed out by the detainee, in presence of executive magistrate and civil witness, found soap cases wrapped in small transparent plastic polythene containing suspected contraband Heroin No. 4 powder being kept concealed in fuel tank and on counting it was 24 (twenty-four) numbers of soap containing suspected contraband heroin no. 4 powder. That, on weighing the said Heroin No. 4 Powder (including the weight of the small transparent plastic polythene used to wrap the suspected heroine no. 4 powder) using weighing scale which we brought with us, it is found to be 1 Kg 721 grams (approx). Then, the 24 (twenty-four) soap cases containing suspected Heroin No. 4 powder were put inside a cartoon box, the same box is wrapped with plastic adhesive tape in the presence of executive magistrate and civil witness.

Consequently, in presence of executive magistrate and civil witness, the detainee **Md. Mustakim (29 yrs), s/o (L) Md. Yusuf Khan of Malrenkhul, Sangaiyumpham Part-1, Thoubal PS, Thoubal District** was arrested at Khabam Chumbreithong, IE at 5.10 p.m. by observing due formalities and from his possession seized (i) 24 (twenty-four) soap cases containing suspected Heroin No. 4 powder with a total weight of 1 Kg 721 grams (approx) including the weight of the small transparent plastic polythene used to wrap the suspected heroine no. 4 powder, (ii) Maruti Swift car bearing r/no. – AS 01 BE 7900 having Engine no. D13A0317255 & Chassis no. MA3FHEB1S00334759 along with smart registration card, (iii) one mobile phone POCO black in colour bearing IMEI Nos. (a) 868331071328181, and (b) 868331071328199 along with one SIM card bearing mobile no. – 9863442864, (iv) one wallet containing a sum of Rs. 720/- (seven hundred and twenty), (v) one AADHAR Card having no. 2141 6275 0479 and (vi) one driving license from the spot i.e. Khabam Chumbreithong IE, at 5:30 p.m.

On further verification, the arrestee stated that the above seized Heroin no. 4 powder belongs to Md. Ibungo, aged about 34 yrs, from Nungphou, Sangaiyumpham Part-1, Thoubal District and on the instruction of the said Md. Ibungo, he took the above seized suspected Heroin no. 4 powder from Nungphou Pakhamyum, Sangaiyumpham Part-1, Thoubal District for onward transportation to Guwahati, Assam. He further stated that he was about to receive a sum of Rs. 30, 000/- (thirty thousand) as transportation charge from Md. Ibungo.

Therefore, the arrestee along with and the seized items are being handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action against him.
