Vengnom, Mantripukhri near IGAR, Khabam Lamkhai, Porompat, Imphal East District, Manipur-795005, currently residing at Tuibong, Churachanpur District, Manipur-795128 stated that on 3 May 2023, at about 7:00pm, his house located at K. Vengnom, Mantripukhri, near IGAR Khabam Lamkhai, Porompat Imphal West District, Manipur-795005, was attacked by a group of unknown Meetei persons armed with guns, knives and sticks. The attackers chanted slogans including "hao hatlo, Kuki hatlo" ( meaning " Kill the tribals, kill the Kuki"). They forcibly entered my kutcha house, comprising of 2 rooms, set fire to the premises, looted and destroyed my household belongings, furniture, electronic, and important documents. On 4 May 2023 they were conveyed by the Assam Rifle in a bullet-proof vehicle in a convoy of 20 persons from Mantripukhri to Kangpokpi. On the 7<sup>th</sup> day (i.e. 7 May 2023) they reached Kangpokpi. Our previous residence (K. Vengnom, Mantripukhri, near IGAR Khabam Lamkhai, Porompat Imphal West District, Manipur-795005) is now abandoned. they are currently residing at Tuibong, Churachanpur District, Manipur-795128.
