1. Details of the incident: On 3 May 2023, at about 7:00 pm, my house located at Khabam Vengnom, IGAR South, Kontha Khabam, Imphal East, Manipur-795002, was attacked by a group of unknown Meetei persons armed with guns, knives and sticks. The attackers chanted slogans including "Hao hatlo, Kuki hatlo"(meaning "Kill the tribals, kill the Kuki"). They forcibly entered my residential home/house i.e., 2 storey RCC Pucca Building situated at Khabam Vengnom, IGAR South, Kontha Khabam, Imphal East, Manipur-795002, set fire to the premises, looted and destroyed my household belongings, furniture, electronics, and important documents. On the morning of 4 May 2023, at about 8:00 am, I along with my family left the area with the assistance of the Central forces we were conveyed by the Assam Rifles in a bullet-proof vehicle, in a convoy of 20 persons, from Mantripukhri to Kangpokpi. On the 7th day (i.e., 7 May 2023) we reached Kangpokpi. Our previous residence as mentioned herein above is now abandoned. We are currently residing at, Tuibuong, Churachandpur district, Manipur.

3. Nature of offence & consequences: The offences committed include arson, destruction of property, looting/theft, intimidation, and ethnic violence targeted at the tribal/Kuki community. The attack has caused: * My house being burnt and rendered uninhabitable. * Loss/destruction/looting of furniture, electronics, documents, other belongings. Displacement of my family, mental trauma, fear of further violence, and disruption of life. Because of post-traumatic stress and fear, I was for a considerable time unaware of the process to file an FIR or approach the authorities.

4. Delay in lodging complaint -explanation & request for condonation:

I wish to respectfully state that this complaint and request for FIR registration is being made after a delay. e) Consider referral to any State or Central relief/compensation scheme applicable to victims of communal/ethnic violence, given the destruction, displacement and trauma suffered by me and my family.

f) Condonation of the delay in filing this complaint/FIR in view of the serious circumstances described above and ensure that the delay does not result in prejudice to my rights.
