Received one zero FIR No, 00-132(12)2025 HLP-PS u/s 380 /427/34-IPC from HLP-PS filed by one Mrs. Mrs. Lamjakap Touthang(37)yrs S/o - Paokholun Touthang of Quarter No.85, 7 Manipur rifles, Khabeisoi, Imphal east District, Manipur A/p Janglenphai Village , Churachandpur District, Manipur stated that the large-scale looting,theft,unlawful occupation,an destruction of my movable property from my former official quarter during the period of conflict in Manipur.

1. Place of Occurrence

Quarter No.85, 7 MR, Khabeisoi, P.O.& P.S.- Heingang, District-Imphal East, Manipur-795001.

2. Time/Period of Occurrence

* Initial displacement:7th May 2023 at around 10:00 a.m.

* Probable period of looting and trespass: Between 7th May 2023 and 1st November 2025

Date of receiving confirmed information: 1st November 2025 at around 10:00 a.m.

3. Circumstances Leading to Displacement

That on 7th May 2023, at approximately 10:00 a.m., the sudden and violent escalation of ethnic conflict across Manipur created an atmosphere of imminent danger, grave insecurity, and severe threat to life, forcing me and my family to immediately abandon our Government Quarter at Quarter No.85, 7 MR, Khabeisoi. The situation was characterized by widespread violence, targeted attacks, and a complete breakdown of civil order. The environment became so hostile that remaining at the premises even for a short duration posed a serious risk to our lives. As a result, we were compelled to evacuate the residence without notice and take urgent refuge in Zanglenphai Village, Churachandpur, where we have continued to reside for our safety and survival. Between 7th May 2023 and 1st November 2025, I was entirely unable to access or verify the condition of my property owing to: Continuous conflict and unstable



law-and-order conditions, buffer zones, barricades, and heavily restricted movement, Fear of physical assault, targeting, or fatal attack on displaced individuals. Absence of safe passage to the affected region. These circumstances made it physically impossible, unsafe, and life-threatening to visit or assess the status of my former residence.

4. Discovery of Looting and Unlawful Occupation: That on 1st November 2025, at approximately 10:00 a.m., I received credible, verified, and trustworthy information from reliable sources confirming that my former residence at Quarter No.85, 7 MR, Khabeisoi had been completely looted by unknown miscreants. Additional Critical Information: Unlawful Occupation Based on the said information received on 1st November 2025, it has further come to my knowledge that my Government Quarter had been unlawfully occupied by unknown persons without my consent, authority, or knowledge. This unauthorized occupation constitutes criminal trespass, illegal possession, and wrongful entry under law, in addition to the offences of theft and destruction of property. The combined acts of looting, house trespass, unlawful occupancy, and illegal removal of property clearly establish deliberate criminal intent on the part of unknown offenders.

5. Extent of Loss: The total financial loss sustained due to the looting and unlawful acts is estimated at 8,78,000 (Rupees Eight Lakh Seventy-Eight Thousand only), excluding the emotional, personal, and sentimental value of items accumulated over several years. A detailed inventory of the looted and destroyed properties is enclosed as Annexure A-1.

6. The delay in filing the present Zero FIR is neither intentional nor negligent, but wholly due to circumstances beyond my control, including: Inaccessibility of the area for over two years, Threat to life and physical harm in attempting to return, Absence of reliable information from the conflict zone, Confirmation of the incident only on 1st November 2025. This FIR is being submitted immediately upon receiving confirmed knowledge of the offences. The delay is therefore bonafide, unavoidable, and legally justified.

7. In light of the above facts, I most respectfully request your esteemed office to:

1. Kindly register this Zero FIR under the relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, including offences relating to: Theft, House trespass, Mischief, Criminal trespass, Unlawful occupation, Destruction of property, Any other applicable criminal provisions;
2. Conduct a thorough, impartial, and time-bound investigation into the looting, theft, and unlawful occupation of my property;
3. Identify the unknown offenders involved in the criminal acts and take strict legal action against them;
4. Record statements, collect evidence, and obtain intelligence inputs from the locality where the offence took place;
5. Extend necessary assistance and protection to me as a displaced and affected citizen. Hence the case.

Presently residing at Zanglenphai Village, District – Churachandpur, Manipur – 795128, and formerly residing at Quarter No.85, 7 MR, Khabeisoi, P.O. & P.S. – Heingang, District – Imphal East, Manipur – 795001, most respectfully submit this Zero First Information Report (Zero FIR) for your kind consideration and immediate necessary action. This complaint pertains to the large-scale looting, theft, unlawful occupation, and destruction of my movable property from my former official quarter during the period of conflict in Manipur.


