## 12. First Information contents:

One complainant namely Deepika Chanu (32) D/o U. Dhananjoy Singh of Thangmeiband Yumnam leikai, Imphal West District, Manipur reported to OC/IPS stating that she was born biologically male and transgender. In 2020, She underwent sex reassignment surgery, and the Deputy Commissioner, Imphal West, recognizing her as female under the relevant Act and Rules, duly issued an identity card and certificate in her name. That ever since her transition, her family members, particularly her elder brother Usham Dinachandra Singh, his wife Anamika, and her mother Prabha Devi, have been ill-treating her, humiliating her for her gender identity, and subjecting her to mental and physical abuse. That on 5th November 2025, at around 9:00 a.m., her cousin Usham Gandhi Singh, who also habitually abuses her for being a transwoman, entered her house. She expressed her disagreement with his behaviour in a calm manner, without confronting her aggressively. That at that moment, her elder brother Dinachandra, who was in the courtyard, raised his voice, saying he did not want to hear her voice. He then rushed towards her and attempted to thrash her. Fearing for her safety, she escaped and took shelter at the house of her cousin Usham Herojit Singh, located on the southern side of her residence. She stayed there until about 5:00 p.m. That upon her return home, she was forcibly taken inside the house by her elder brother, Usham Dinachandra, with the assistance of her sister-in-law, Okram Ningol Usham Ongbi Anamika, and her mother, Prabha Devi. They collectively assaulted her, beating her severely. No one intervened to stop the assault. That as a result of the assault, she suffered multiple injuries, including swelling on her left foot, causing difficulty in bearing weight, superficial injuries on her abdomen, and tearing of her clothes. The brutality of the attack, committed by multiple family members working in concert, caused severe physical pain and emotional trauma. That the incident dated 5th November 2025 is not an isolated occurrence but part of a continuous pattern of discrimination, verbal humiliation, intimidation, and physical violence inflicted upon her solely because of her gender identity as a transwoman. Such conduct not only violates her fundamental right to live with dignity but also constitutes repeated and targeted abuse prohibited under the law. That despite her efforts to maintain peace within the household, the accused persons have consistently subjected her to degrading treatment, calling her derogatory names, questioning her gender identity, and attempting to socially isolate her. Their actions create an unsafe and hostile living environment and amount to criminal intimidation and cruelty. That the deliberate act of forcibly dragging her inside the house and assaulting her by three adults amounts to a coordinated attack with the intention to cause harm, shame, and fear. The tearing of her shirt during the assault further amounts to an outrage of modesty, attracting provisions relating to offences against women under the IPC. That she is living under constant fear of further violence from her own family members. Their discriminatory conduct and violent behaviour have made it impossible for her to reside peacefully in her own home without immediate intervention from law enforcement. Their acts constitute offences under various provisions under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanita (BNS) and also amount to offences under the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019. The continued acts of coercion, exclusion, and emotional abuse inflicted upon the complainant by the accused persons, thereby depriving her of her right to live with dignity and security, are punishable under the aforesaid provisions of law. The repeated acts of verbal abuse, discriminatory treatment, threats, expulsion from safe residence, and the physical assault committed on 5th November 2025 fall squarely within these punishable offences under the Act. She therefore humbly requested to register an FIR against the above-named persons and take necessary legal action at the earliest.
