The brief fact of the case is that on 28/03/2025 at about 1900 hrs received reliable input that one Kaikhohao Kipgen @ John (40) yrs. s/o (L) Jangkholam Kipgen of Kangpokpi ward no. 4 near Saraswati Hindi School, was about to transport contraband (reportedly Brown Sugar) to Senapati in a white Bolero. Upon receiving this information, a police team of KPI-PS led by ASP(LO) KPI under the supervision of SP/Kangpokpi raided the residence of Kaikhohao Kipgen @John. During the process, the said individual was found along with 2 (two) of his friends (Aabi Baral, 28 yrs S/o Hari Prasad of Songpekjang village, Kangpokpi and Jitten Kharka, 22 yrs S/o Chandra Bahadur Kharka of Silem, Lairouching, Senapati District) in the corner of the house and one suspicious white Bolero bearing R/N MN01AS 2542 was parked in the premises. The two individuals (Aabi & Jitten) were taken to Kangpokpi-PS for verification. However, during the preliminary enquiring, it was learnt that John is a ranked member of KNF (P) SoO group. Considering the prevailing law and order situation he was taken to SPT-PS for further necessary action.

On reaching Senapati-PS, John was questioned about the presence of contraband drugs inside his vehicle but he denied it. However, he disclosed that the suspected vehicle (Bolero) was received from one Letgoumang Touthang near Sehjang village along NH-37 by Aabi & Jitten who were with him at his residence when my team reached at the spot. Initially, when the vehicle (Bolero) was searched, could not find any illegal items. The information was reliable so the vehicle was kept at Senapati-PS for further verification

Today i.e 29/3/2025, in the morning at 8:30 am, strip searched of the aforesaid Bolero was done in presence of Executive Magistrate and John, and during which, a suspicious additional modification in the form of roof spoiler was noticed at the end of the roof top. On further removing the spoiler, a metal sheet with two screw was seen. When the screws were opened there was a hidden compartment found containing soap cases (suspected to be containing contraband drugs). Further, in presence of the duty Magistrate, John was instructed to take out the soap cases (suspected to be containing brown sugar) one by one which were concealed neatly inside the rear roof top. On opening one soap case by duty

Magistrate, it was highly suspected to be contraband drugs (suspected to be Brown Sugar). On counting the soap cases the total number is 128. The soap cases were marked 1, 2, 3, 4128 (One hundred twenty-eight). The soap cases which were marked 1-40 is keep inside one transparent polythene bag and marked as Lot-1. Similarly, the soap cases marked 41-80 is keep inside one transparent polythene bag marking as Lot-2. Again, 81-128 is kept inside one transparent polythene bag and marked as Lot-3. On weighing the Lots, Lot-1 weighs 1.505 kgs, Lot-2 weighs 1.530 kgs and Lot-3 weighs 1.815 kgs. The total weight of all Lots is 4.855 kgs inclusive of the weight of soap cases and transparent polythene.

On completion of legal formalities, the signature of duty Magistrate, police witnesses and John were obtained on the Extraction and Weighing Memo and Seizure Memo at 12:30 pm on the same day at Senapati-PS campus. And also, John was arrested at 12: 35 pm on the same day at Senapati-PS campus and he was requisitioned at Senapati-PS for safe custody.
