The brief fact of the case is that on 05/06/2025 at 2:30 pm based on source report, who provided the photograph and detail particulars of one drugs-peddler, was transporting illegal drugs in one unknown vehicle which is moving towards Kangpokpi from Imphal. Immediately, a joint teams comprising KPI-PS led by OC/KPI-PS assisted by SI Rex Haotinal DOUNGEL, ASI L. Lienjakai Haokip and ASI Khuptinkai Gangte and QAT (Quick Action Team) of 112 Bn. CRPF under the overall instruction of Shri Tholu Rocky MPS, ASP(LO)/KPI and ASP(HQ) KPI conducted intensive frisking and checking of vehicles at different locations under the jurisdiction of Kangpokpi-PS on the same day. During which, the police team led by OC/KPI-PS and ASI Khuptinkai Gangte stopped one CAR Hyundai (Sleek silver in colour) B/R No. AS09E-5550 at near Daili village at 3:30 pm and on verifying the driver and occupant, the occupant was looking matching with that of the photograph provided by my source man. At the same time, the identity of the occupant was identified as A. Dahnii (31) s/o Abraham of Thingba Khullen village, PO: Karong, PS: Tadubi, Senapati District who is similar with that of the detail particulars provided by my source man. The driver was also identified as M. Ngaiyu Vekhe (35) s/o (L) Maikho of Thingba Khullen village, PO: Karong, PS: Tadubi, Senapati District who was suspected to be one of the associates of the detained A. Dahnii.

On preliminary questioning, he disclosed that he has concealed illegal drugs inside his vehicle. On confirming the presence of the illegal drugs, the complainant had informed the matter to one executive magistrate of Kangpokpi, requested for his presence at the spot to witness the legal formalities to be performed. On his arrival at the spot, the complainant had requested the magistrate to take the vehicle to Kangpokpi-PS as the spot being National Highway having traffic congestion and being accident-prone area, causing inconveniences. Accordingly, the vehicle along with the detained individuals were taken to Kangpokpi-PS which is just 1.5 kms away from the spot.

On arrival at KPI-PS campus, in presence of the Executive Magistrate, the detained A. Dahnii had voluntarily taken out the concealed soap cases (suspected to be brown-sugar) beneath the front foot-rest on both sides by opening himself. The said soap cases were counted one by one on production by Dahnii and the total is 75(seventy-five) soap cases. The recovered soap cases were marked as 1, 2, 3.....till 75. The soap cases marked as 1-15 were put into one transparent polythene bag and marked as Lot-1. Similarly, the soap cases marked 16-30 as Lot-2, the soap cases marked 31-46 as Lot-3, the soap cases marked 47-60 as Lot-4 & the soap cases marked 61-70 as Lot-5 for identification. On weighing the Lots i.e. Lot-1 weighs 576 grams, Lot-2 weighs 580 grams, Lot-3 weighs 582 grams, Lot-4 weighs 575 grams and Lot-5 weighs 576grams including the weight of the transparent polythene bags. The total weight of all the lots weighted 2.889 kgs including the weight of the soap cases and transparent polythene bags.

The recovered items suspected to be Brown sugar and other articles were seized in the presence of Executive Magistrate, witnesses and apprehended persons by preparing a formal seizure memo at 4:10 pm by obtaining their signatures.
