Sir,

I have the honour to submit this complaint report to the effect that today, the 27th January, 2026, at about 03:00 PM, while I, Head Constable K. Nepolian Singh of CDO Unit, Kakching, along with a joint naka party of District Police Kakching and Kakching Police Station team led by SI Govinda Khundongbam, were deployed on routine mobile check post duty at Pallel near Pallel New Bridge along NH-102 / Pallel Thongkhong Anouba for precautionary checking, one Suzuki Access scooter bearing Registration No. MN-01-AQ-4991 (Ice Green & White colour) coming from Tengnoupal side towards Kakching Lamkhai was intercepted for routine frisking and checking.

On questioning, the rider disclosed his identity as Sunilkumar Sahani, aged 28 years, S/o Govin Sahani, resident of Moreh Ward No. 3(B), Tengnoupal District, Manipur.

During checking of the said vehicle, six (06) small-size boxes wrapped with black coloured plastic were found concealed beneath the tool box of the said scooter. On further checking, another five (05) small-size boxes wrapped with black coloured plastic were found concealed inside the front portion near the battery chamber, thus making a total of eleven (11) small boxes.

In order to ensure fairness, transparency and strict compliance with legal procedure, the accused was clearly informed of his legal right under Section 50 of the NDPS Act that he could be searched in the presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer, if he so desired. After being so informed, the accused voluntarily expressed his willingness and opted that the search and further proceedings be conducted in the presence of a Gazetted Officer. Accordingly, the presence of a Gazetted Officer was requisitioned and senior officers were informed. After some time, Shri Shankerjit S. Loitongbam, Addl. Superintendent of Police (L&O), Kakching (Gazetted Officer) arrived at the spot and, after again confirming the willingness of the accused, further proceedings were conducted in his presence.

In the presence of the said Gazetted Officer, the naka party and independent witness, the said eleven (11) small boxes were opened and found to contain blue-coloured soap cases containing suspected Heroin (Brown Sugar / Heroin No. 4) powder. From the possession of the accused, the following items were recovered and seized from the spot at about 03:45 PM by observing all legal formalities and videography of the proceedings was done:

1. Eleven (11) blue-coloured soap cases containing suspected Heroin (Brown Sugar).
2. One Access 125 B/R No. MN01AQ-4991 Ice Green & White colour with key
3. One Samsung Galaxy S25 Ultra mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 356284536332810 and IMEI-2: 356537896332815 fitted with two SIM cards (JIO - 9366118300 and Airtel - 7085559209).

At the place of recovery, the eleven (11) soap cases containing suspected Heroin were weighed one by one in a digital weighing machine in the presence of the Gazetted Officer and witness

and were found to weigh approximately 124 grams in total (excluding the weight of the soap cases). The weighing and seizure process were videographed.

Accordingly, the accused Sunilkumar Sahani was formally arrested at about 4.30 PM from the spot by observing all legal formalities and was informed of the grounds of arrest and his legal rights. Immediate intimation regarding his arrest and place of detention was conveyed to his relatives. The accused and all seized articles were then brought to Kakching Police Station for further necessary legal action.

The above acts prima facie constitute offences under the provisions of the NDPS Act and other relevant laws. Hence, this complaint is submitted for kindly registering a case, taking up investigation and doing the needful as per law.
