Subject: - Report



Sir,

I have the honour to submit this complaint to the effect that today, the 21/1/2026, at about 03:00 PM, while I, Sub No. 596 Ksh. Prakash Singh of CDO Unit, Kakching, along with a joint naka party of District Police Kakching comprising HC L. Kunjakeshwar Singh, HC L. Rohit Singh of CDO Kakching Unit including women personnel and the Kakching Police Station team led by SI Govinda Khundongbam, were deployed on routine mobile check post duty at Pallel Maning Pathabi along Pallel IVR Road for taking precautionary measures in connection with the forthcoming Republic Day celebration, one Activa scooter bearing Registration No. MN-01-AN-1942 (black colour) coming from Khuninglung Village side towards Pallel Maning Leikai was intercepted for routine frisking and checking. On questioning, the rider disclosed her identity as Veromica Moyon, aged 28 years, W/o Belove Moyon of Thangkin Village, Chandel District, and the pillion rider disclosed his identity as Chihanring Shinglai, aged 32 years, S/o Ninghui Shinglai of Thotchanram Village, Chandel District.

During checking of the said vehicle, one grey-coloured handbag kept upon the footrest portion of the scooter appeared suspicious. In order to ensure fairness, transparency and strict compliance of legal procedure, both the accused persons were clearly informed of their legal right that they could be searched in the presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer, if they so desired. After being so informed, both the accused persons voluntarily expressed their willingness and opted that the search and further proceedings may be conducted in the presence of a Gazetted Officer. Accordingly, I immediately requisitioned the presence of a Gazetted Officer and informed my senior officers. After some time, Smt. Kh. Hemabati, SDPO Kakching (Gazetted Officer) arrived at the spot and in her presence, after again confirming the willingness of the accused persons, the search of the suspected bag and further proceedings were conducted.

In the presence of the said Gazetted Officer and the naka party, the said handbag, which formed part of the belongings of the accused was opened and checked and on inspection twenty-five (25) soap cases suspected to contain Heroin No.4 were recovered, consisting of nine (9) maroon-coloured soap cases, six (6) green-coloured soap cases, five (5) blue-coloured soap cases, four (4) white-coloured soap cases and one (1) white and green mixed-coloured soap case. From the possession and production of Veromica Moyon, the recovered 25 soap cases along with one Samsung mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 358358101803716 and IMEI-2: 358358101803714 fitted with Airtel SIM No. 8798614542 were seized from the spot at about 03:53 PM by observing all legal formalities, and videography of the proceedings was done in the presence of the Gazetted Officer.

Thereafter, from the possession and production of Chihanring Shinglai, one Plus mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 863809076401256 and IMEI-2: 863809076401249 fitted with Airtel SIM No. 7629009611, along with one Aadhaar Card No. 3685-0463-5389, were also seized from the spot at about 04:00 PM by observing due formalities and videography of the same was also done in the presence of the Gazetted Officer.

At the place of recovery, it was observed that the area was an open stretch and the weather condition was extremely windy in nature. The electronic weighing machine being highly sensitive, even slight air movement causes fluctuation in readings, particularly when narcotic packets are light and precise measurement is crucial for evidentiary purposes.

Moreover, there was no suitable enclosed or stable platform available at the spot for conducting accurate weighing and sampling without risk of error or contamination. Therefore, in order to preserve the sanctity of evidence and to ensure accurate and reliable measurement, weighing and sampling of the recovered suspected contraband could not be carried out at the spot.

Accordingly, both the accused persons namely Veromica Moyon and Chihanring Shinglai were formally arrested one after another at about 04:10 PM and 04:15 PM respectively from the spot by observing all legal formalities, and all the seized items along with the arrested accused persons were immediately brought to Kakching Police Station for further necessary legal action. Upon arrival at the Police Station, in the presence of the Gazetted Officer, the recovered twenty-five soap cases containing suspected Heroin No.4 powder were weighed one by one and found to weigh approximately 299 grams in total (excluding the weight of the soap cases). The weighing process was videographed. Thereafter, the seized soap cases containing

suspected Heroin No.4 powder were properly packed, sealed and labelled at Kakching Police Station in the presence of the Gazetted Officer and videography of the packing and sealing process was also done.

Immediate intimation regarding the arrest and place of detention of the accused persons was duly conveyed to their relatives and the accused were informed of the grounds of arrest and their legal rights and were treated strictly in accordance with law. The seized contraband, samples and other seized articles have been taken into safe custody for further legal action and forwarding to the forensic laboratory through proper channel.

Since the above facts disclose the commission of cognizable offences punishable under the relevant provisions of the NDPS Act, I humbly request you to kindly register a case and take up investigation in accordance with law. The accused persons along with the seized items are hereby produced before you for further necessary legal action
